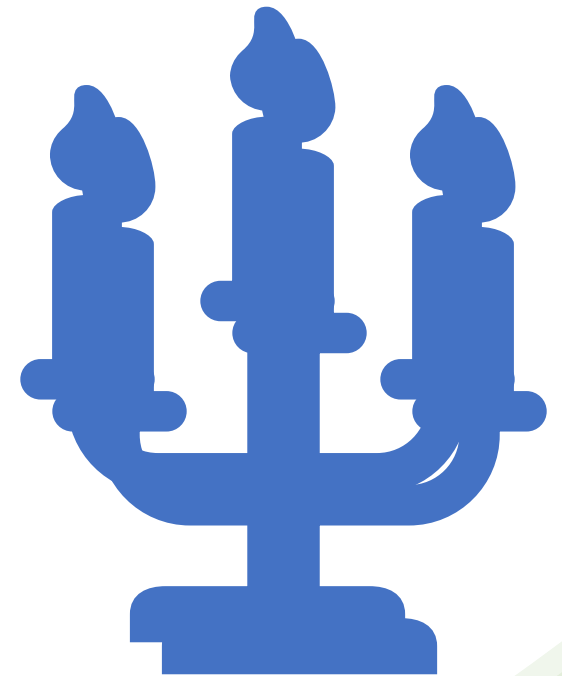


The Person of the Holy Spirit



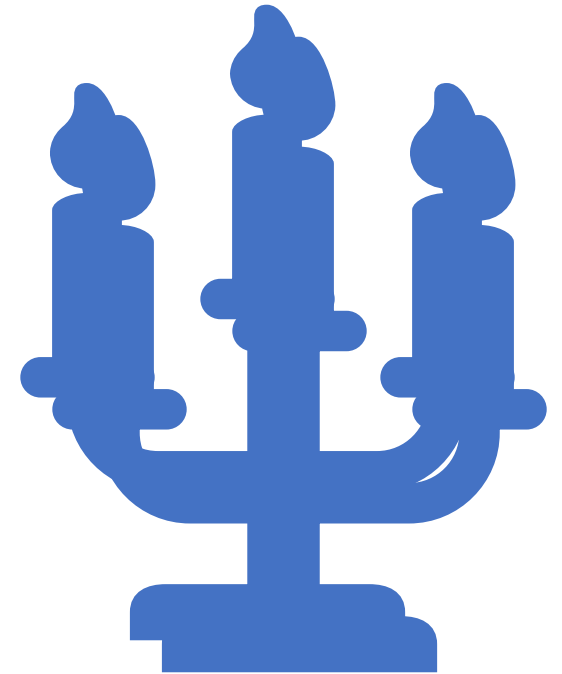
Who is the Holy Spirit in the New Testament?

As the third person of the Trinity, the Holy Spirit's nature is consistent in the Old and New Testaments. His role was only slightly different under the two covenants. He enabled believers to trust God, live holy lives, and serve the Lord Father and Eternal Son in power.



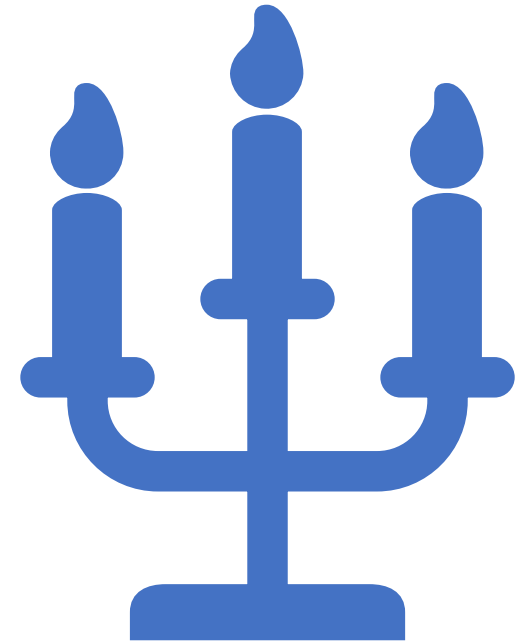
What is He like (His Personality) as described in the New Testament?

paráklētos /pará, "from close-beside" and /kaléō, "make a call") – properly, a legal advocate who makes the right judgment-call because close enough to the situation. 3875 /paráklētos ("advocate, advisor-helper") is the regular term in NT times of an attorney (lawyer) – i.e., someone giving evidence that stands up in court. He is our defence counsel.



How does He act in the New Testament?

The Holy Spirit acts in the New Testament as the one who proceeds from the Father and the Son to act as the active divine co-agent in regeneration, redemption, sanctification and glorification in the life of believers.

For the **Holy Spirit** will teach you in that very hour what you ought to say.”




The promise of the Holy Spirit

- [John 7:39](#)
- But this He spoke concerning the **Spirit**, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the **Holy Spirit** was not yet *given*, because Jesus was not yet glorified.
- [John 14:26](#)
- But the Helper, the **Holy Spirit**, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.


The Work of the Holy Spirit (convict the world of sin)

John 16 ⁷ Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you. ⁸ And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: ⁹ of sin, because they do not believe in Me; ¹⁰ of righteousness, because I go to My Father and you see Me no more; ¹¹ of judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.



The Work of Holy Spirit (teacher) continued

John 16 ¹² “I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear *them* now. ¹³ However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own *authority*, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. ¹⁴ He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare *it* to you. ¹⁵ All things that the Father has are Mine. Therefore I said that He ^[c] will take of Mine and declare *it* to you.



The Spirit of Truth (helper)

John 15 ¹⁵ “If you love Me, ^[d]keep My commandments. ¹⁶ And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another ^[e]Helper, that He may abide with you forever— ¹⁷ the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you. ¹⁸ I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you.

Acts 1 The Holy Spirit Promised

⁴ And being assembled together with *them*, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, “which,” *He said*, “you have heard from Me; ⁵ for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.” ⁶ Therefore, when they had come together, they asked Him, saying, “Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?” ⁷ And He said to them, “It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has put in His own authority. ⁸ But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be ^[c]witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”

The promise of the Holy Spirit fulfilled


Acts 2v1 When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all [a]with one accord in one place. ² And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. ³ Then there appeared to them [b]divided tongues, as of fire, and *one* sat upon each of them. ⁴ And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

And those of the circumcision who believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because the gift of the **Holy Spirit** had been poured out on the Gentiles also.




The Holy Speaks

As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, the **Holy Spirit** said, “Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them.”

Now when they had gone through Phrygia and the region of Galatia, they were forbidden by the **Holy Spirit** to preach the word in Asia.



The Holy Spirit brings hope and love.

- Romans 5 Therefore, having been justified by faith, [\[a\]](#)we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, ² through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. ³ And not only *that*, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces [\[b\]](#)perseverance; ⁴ and perseverance, [\[c\]](#)character; and character, hope. ⁵ Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the **Holy Spirit** who was given to us.

The Holy Spirit teaches us

[1 Corinthians 2:13](#)

These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches but which the **Holy Spirit** teaches, comparing **spiritual** things with **spiritual**.



We are the temple of the Holy Spirit

- Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the **Holy Spirit** *who is* in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own?



Sealed with the Holy Spirit

In Him you also *trusted*, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the **Holy Spirit** of promise,

And do not grieve the **Holy Spirit** of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

[1 Thessalonians 1:5](#)


For our gospel did not come to you in word only, but also in power, and in the **Holy Spirit** and in much assurance, as you know what kind of men we were among you for your sake.
