6:4 Internship Curriculum Statement

The 6:4 Internship exists to equip godly men who sense His call to the ministry through a practical training program and an environment of spiritual fellowship and relationships which emphasize unreserved commitment to the worship of God, submission to the authority of the Scriptures, a life of personal holiness, the priority of the local church, and the mission of penetrating the world with the Truth.

6:4 Internship Program Learning Outcomes

- PLO #1: *As a future elder, pastor, missionary or educator,* comprehend the significant areas of Christian Theology, Leadership, Pastoral Ministry, and Public Proclamation.
- PLO #2: *As a future elder/pastor,* develop an understanding of what pastoral ministry is as defined by the word of God and cultivate those traits with application in mind towards one's desired ministerial aspirations.
- PLO #3: *As a future teacher of the Scripture,* grasp the essential theological constructs needed to live, preach and teach the Bible to varied age levels and abilities within any ministry context.
- PLO #4: *As a future spiritual leader,* exhibit the disciplines of holiness, prayer, and compassion required for ministry.

I. COURSE DESCRIPTION

Semester 3: Public Proclamation will teach and test your understanding of and ability to lead God's people by way of effective communication, especially as it pertains to teaching and preaching.

Select a preacher from church history (Chrysostom, Augustine, Luther, Spurgeon, Sproul etc.) and write a 3-5 page paper identifying ONE aspect (preparation process, prayer life, hook, illustrations, exegesis, passion, application, conviction, evangelistic etc.) of his preaching that made it so effective. Show how that aspect shaped his preaching using examples and make a case for why it should influence how you and any other preacher today preaches.

1. Each of you will choose a week(s) out of the semester to facilitate our hour long discussion on the Public Proclamation topic presented. You will be responsible for studying and preparing beforehand (including appropriate Scripture) to lead us in accurately understanding and applying that key pastoral area to our lives and ministries.
