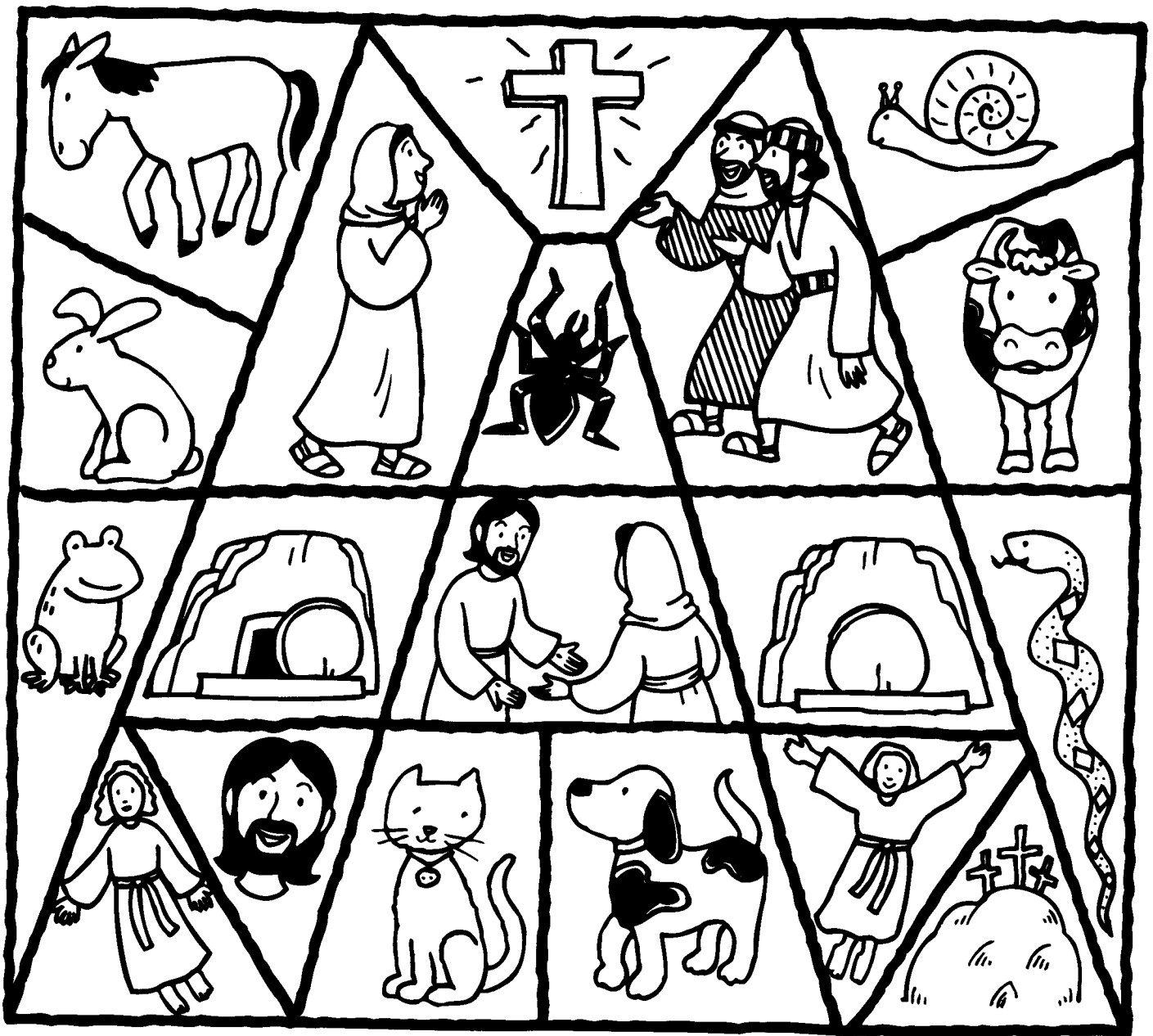


Matthew 26–27; John 18–20: Jesus Is Alive!

Draw an ✕ on all the spaces with pictures of animals. Color in all the other spaces. What shape do you find?



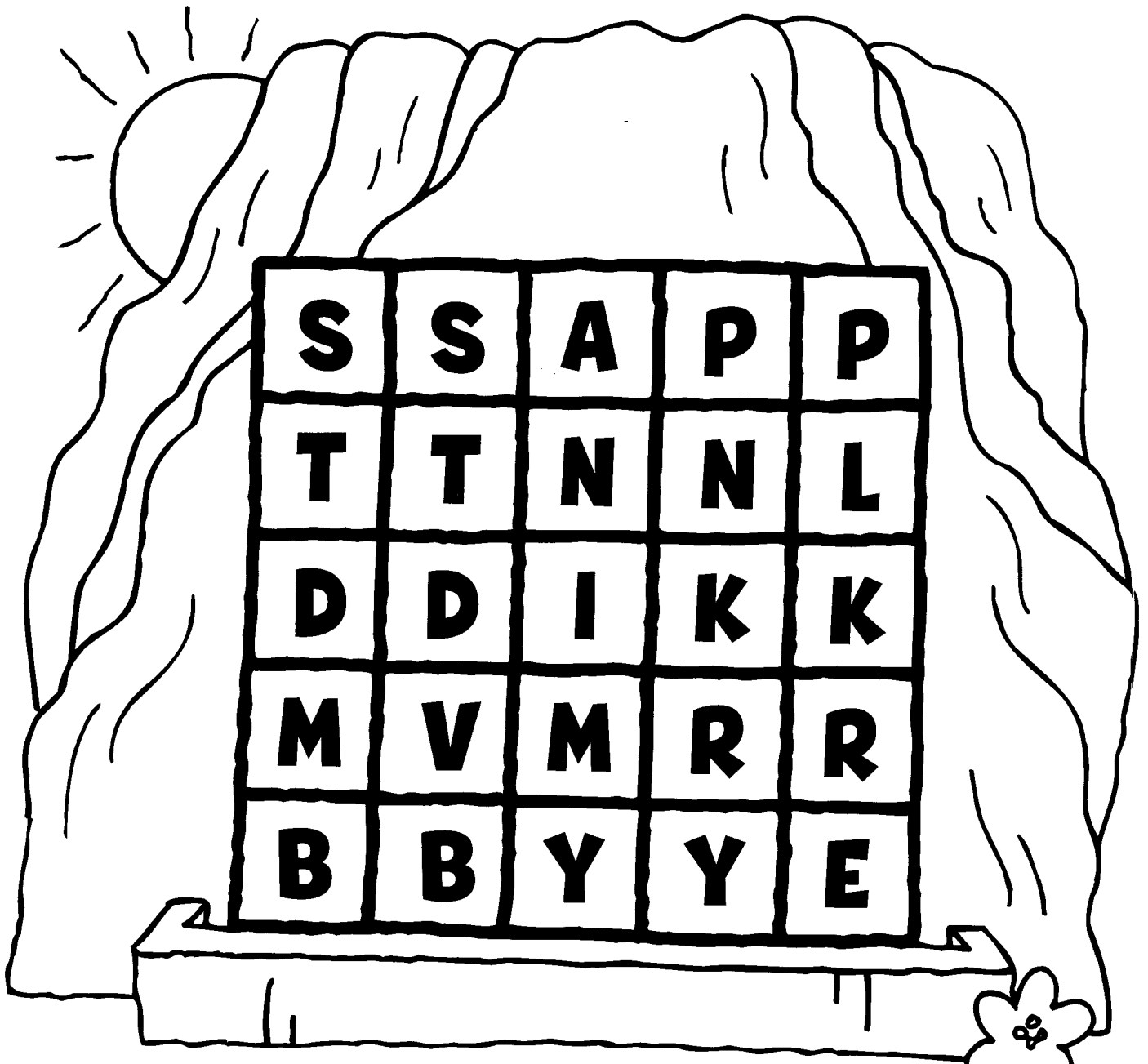

The Bible says, "It is true! The Lord has risen" (Luke 24:34).

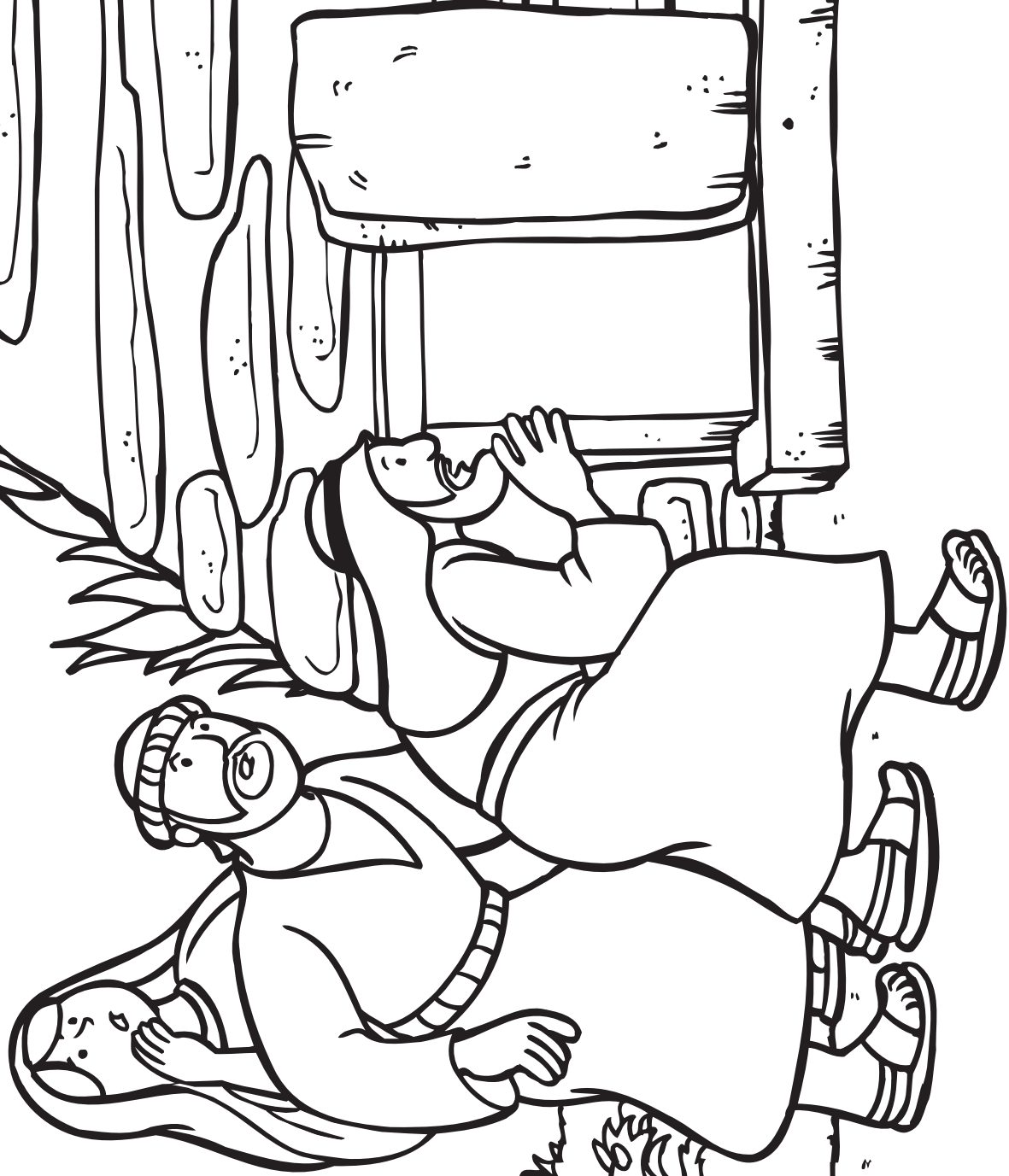

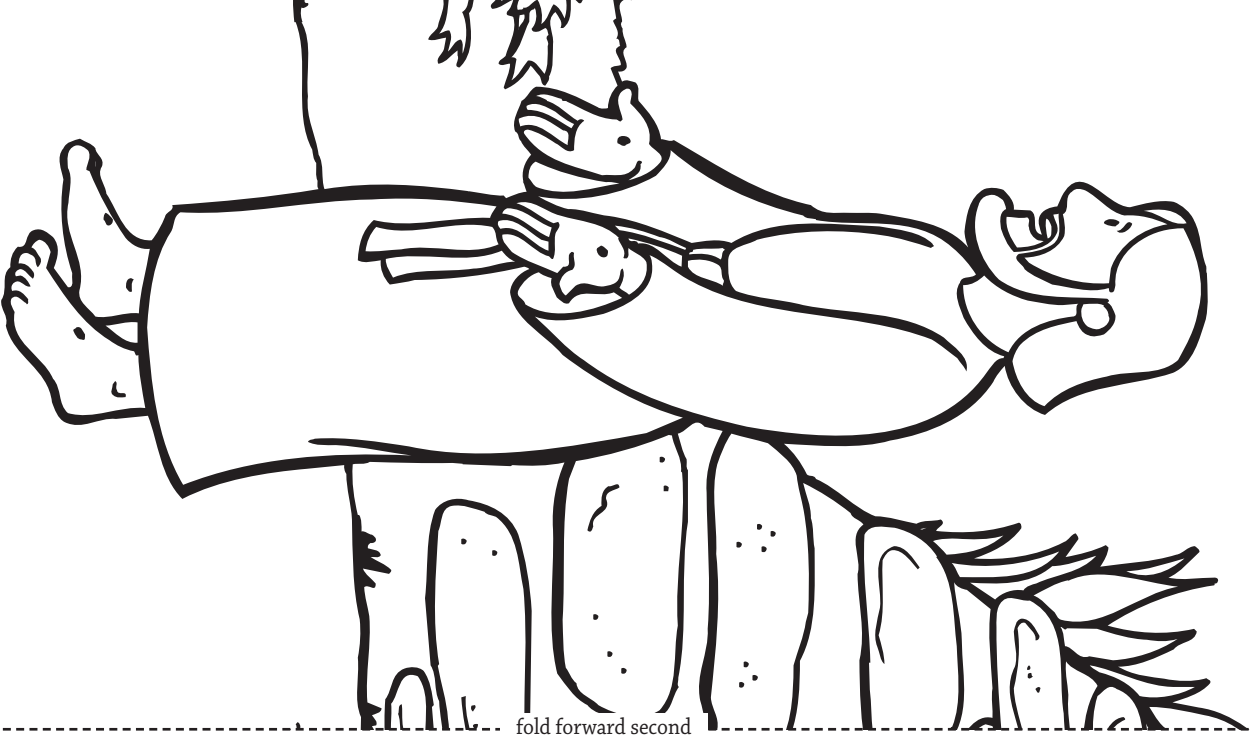
