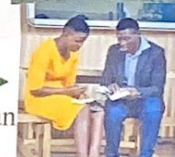

This past quarter the Lord allowed us to see **117 people saved and 16 were baptized.**

The Lord also gave us a new property (at no cost) about 3 hours south of Kampala. We plan



to have a youth camp here and to also start a church for this area. Please be praying for us as there is much work to do with building dormitories and preparing the place for camp. More than half the



population of Uganda is youth, and we must reach these young people with the Gospel.



We now have **2 Bible Colleges and 2 Youth Camps.** Please be praying that the Lord will use these ministries to help us to see more people saved and trained for ministry and that more churches will be started. We already have churches in Rwanda and Uganda, and we are praying for more churches here as well as in South Sudan and Congo.



We have over 300 in the Christian School. It has been a blessing to see many of these children saved.



Starting the Avocado project for the Bible College. Many Bible College students do not have work that is available, so we are starting projects on our property in Arua.

The money that will come from these projects can be used to help buy food and to pay other needs as they are being trained. Please be praying for this project as well as others so that we can train more people in the ministry.

Thank you for praying for my mom, Betty Pridgen. She has been diagnosed with an Autoimmune disease and the doctors gave her a chemotherapy treatment. They were not sure if she would be able to continue this treatment but she is doing well and the treatment is helping her. Please continue to keep her in your prayers.
