(3:8-13) Qualifications for Deacons and Deaconesses

8 Deacons likewise must be dignified, not doubletongued, not addicted to much wine, not greedy for dishonest gain.

DEACON — (diakonos)

Original Word:διάκονος (diakonos)

Definition: a waiter, servant; then of any one who performs any service, an administrator.

"dignified": semnós (an adjective derived from 4576 /sébomai, "to revere, be in awe") - properly, what is august (dignified, has "gravitas"); weighty, deeply respected because viewed as majestic (having "gravity"); grave.

- "not double-tongued": properly,
 "double-saying," i.e. deceitful by saying
 one thing but meaning another –
 literally, "two-sayings" ("doubletongued," used only in 1 Tim 3:8).
- "not addicted to much wine"
- "not greedy for dishonest gain"






