Mary and Joseph had other children
Jesus had earthly brothers, sisters

Fasted 40 days/nights Hungry Physically weak **Tempted** "If you are the Son of God..."

As a man, Jesus needed to pray
His flesh was weak
His Spirit was strong enough to
overcome the flesh

He was in agony Trusted His Father perfectly

Shortened form of Heb. 1 and 2 Jesus is God Took the form of a man **Humbled Himself to become** obedient

Obedient to the point of death on a cross God exalted Him highly Gave Him the name above all names

Every knee will bow before Him Confess Him as Lord
