Luke 9:10-17

- 1. What happened after the twelve returned to Jesus?
- 2. What happened in verses 12-17?

Luke 9:18-22

- 1. How did Jesus' question relate to the other events in this chapter?
- 2. What is the definition of Christ?
- 3. Who do you say He is, especially in light of what you have learned about Jesus thus far in Luke?

4. What did Jesus tell the disciples in verses 21-22?

Luke 9:23-27

- 1. How is Jesus' call in these verses related to what was going to happen to Him?
- 2. For context, what time span is covered in verses 22-27? Yes, include verse 22. (Look for events.)

Note: We will discuss what is said in verse 27 more fully next week. For this week, simply know what the Kingdom of God is referring to. The discovery of truth in verses 26-28 is rewarding. To see it, read verses 26-36 carefully. Next week, I will ask you what the connection is.
