Hebrews Part 2: Jesus, Our Perfect High Priest Forever Lesson 7: Chapter 9, "Old & New Covenant" February 25, 2024

- 1. Carefully read through Hebrews 9. On a separate sheet, formulate an outline of this passage.
- 2. Now, summarize this passage in 10-words or less.

The daily activity in the Tabernacle took place in the outer courtyard (around the bronze altar and the laver), as well as in the first part of the Tent of Meeting (the Holy Place). However, the Holy of Holies, the most Holy Place within the veil (Leviticus 16:2), was only entered on one day each year (Hebrews 9:7), the Day of Atonement.

- 3. The priests carried on routine activity in the Holy Place, where the Table of Shewbread and the Altar of Incense were stationed. What is described in the following Scriptures about what the priests did?
 - a. Exodus 27:20-21 & Leviticus 24:1-4 -
 - b. Leviticus 24:5-9 & Exodus 25:30 -
- 4. Answer the following questions from Hebrews 9:6-10.
 - a. All the activity that went on in the Tabernacle related only to what?
 - b. What did the activities fail to deal with regarding man?
- 5. Hebrews 8:7 indicates that God's "Old Covenant" was "faulty," and needed to be replaced. According to Hebrews 8:6-10, in what way did it fall short and need to be replaced? How is it that a perfect God initiated a "faulty" covenant?

- 6. Look up the Greek word "conscience" and notice where it is used in Hebrews 9 and 10. What do you learn from each use of the word by the author of Hebrews.
- 7. Leviticus 16 details the specifics of what the High Priest was to do on the Day of Atonement. Describe exactly what he was to do on that day.

8. Finally, what parallels and/or contrasts do you see between Christ's sacrifice and the Day of Atonement.
