- 5. What are the three exhortations in 10:19-25? How do we practice these?
- 6. What is the warning in 10:26-31? How does it compare with the others in Hebrews 2-6? Heb. 2:1-4; 3-4; 6:1-8
- 7. What do we learn about deliberate/willful sin from Num. 15:22-31, and how does this compare with Heb. 10:26-29? Look up the verb tense for "go on sinning" in 10:26. What does this tell you? And explain what is happening in 10:29.

8.	How do Deut. 32:35-36 and Ps. 145:20 relate to this in regard to God's character?
9.	What are 10:32-39 about? And what does the author exhort them to do in vv. 35-39?
10	Heb. 10:37-38 quotes Hab. 2:3-4. It was written before the southern kingdom of Judah was taken captive by the Babylonians. Hab. 2:4 is also quoted in Rom. 1:17 and Gal. 3:11. So what did the Jews understand this quote to mean?
11	. What are the definitions of "shrink back" and "destruction?"
12	. What do the following references tell us about the future and the Lord's coming? Are you eagerly awaiting the Lord's return? Heb. 1:13; 2:5; 6:11-12; 9:27-28; 10:25; 12:25-29; 13:14
