Mt. 27:45-53 When Jesus died on the cross Veil tore from top to bottom 10 cubits high 4 inches thick Holy of Holies exposed

Jn. 14:1-6 Jesus to the disciples after Judas left Going away Prepare a place For them to be with Him

Jn. 14:1-6 He is in heaven Preparing a place for believers To be there with Him After He comes for them

Jn. 14:1-6 He is the way To the Father Through the veil, His flesh Into God's presence

Continuing in willful sin After knowing the truth Trampling under foot The Son of God Regarding His blood of NC Unclean

Warning 26-31

Insults the Spirit of grace Result Severer punishment than death Judgment with fury Consuming fire

Warning 26-31

By continuing in willful sin
They know what they are doing

Hebrews 2:1-4

Pay close attention To what one has heard God spoke in His son Don't drift away Don't neglect salvation Result is a just penalty

If one hears His voice Don't harden your heart Hard heart Evil, unbelieving heart

Rejected the truth Cannot be renewed to repentance Similar language to 10:29 No repentance No more sacrifice

Endured Sympathy to prisoners Joyfully accepted Seizure of property Knew owned better, abiding one

Keep on enduring Don't throw away confidence Shrinking back in trials Righteous live by faith To the preserving of their souls
