- 1. To whom is the Epistle of Hebrews written? What was their faith condition?**
  
- 2. Our lesson for this Sunday is conducting an overview of Hebrews 11. Read Hebrews 10:19-11:40 three times, ignoring the chapter division, to get flow of thought. List the author’s observations and exhortations.**
  
- 3. Summarize in 10-words or less the over-all admonition of the passage.**
  
- 4. Focus on the “Lettuce Patch” (10:19-25). In your opinion, which of these three “let us” challenges do you think is the most important? ...and why?**
  
- 5. What distinctions do you see between those who were “dying in faith” (11:4-13) and those who were “living by faith” (11:17-39)?**
  
- 6. As you carefully read Hebrews 11 again, record any personal lessons you learn about what would strengthen your faith.**
  
- 7. Do you have the confidence and assurance that Hebrews 10:19-11:1 speaks about? What makes you think so, or not?**
