Hebrews Review Needed to endure in trials Some returned to Old Covenant

Chapters 1-4: "Faith" Present Jesus as the faithful one 2:17

He became flesh and blood To be the merciful, faithful high priest

Chapters 1-4: "Faith" He's faithful over God's house Believers Moses also faithful as a servant to God

Chapters 1-4: "Faith" God spoke in His Son Jesus

Pay close attention to what He said

Chapters 1-4: "Faith" If you hear His voice Don't harden your heart in unbelief **Evil unbelieving heart** Falls away from the living God

Chapters 1-4: "Faith" Those who didn't believe Didn't enter His rest Chs 3-4: Disobedience = unbelief

Good news preached to us Word they heard did not profit Not united by faith

Chapters 5-10: "Faith" Faith toward God Part of the elementary teaching Believers to press on to maturity

Chapters 5-10: "Faith" Believers are to imitate others Who inherit the promises Through faith and patience Growing in faith is part of maturity

Chapters 5-10: "Faith" 10:22-23 God who promised is faithful

Faith comes from God He's the source and example

Chapters 5-10: "Faith" Because of our faithful high priest Believers can draw near to God In full assurance of faith With a clean conscience

Chapters 5-10: "Faith" The righteous live by faith Even when judgment is coming And times are difficult

Chapters 5-10: "Faith" Perseverance and endurance in faith Lead to The preserving of the believer's soul

Chapters 11: "Faith" The assurance of things hoped for The conviction of things not seen

Same root word as "believe" A conviction resulting in conduct.

Chapters 11: "Faith" True faith Confident obedience to God's Word In spite of circumstances

Chapters 11: "Faith" Necessary for Approval by God **Please Him** Preserving the soul Salvation

Chapters 11: "Faith" Lived out in the lives of the witnesses

Righteous man Lived by faith

Chapters 11: "Faith" Offering approved by God Still an example of a man of faith Did not die

Chapters 11: "Faith" Pleased God by faith Believed what God told him About the coming judgment of flood

Chapters 11: "Faith" **Obediently built the ark** Saved him and his household Righteous man lived by faith Even in light of coming judgment

Chapters 11: "Faith" Faith grew From following God to a foreign land To believing that God would give him a son

Chapters 11: "Faith" When tested to sacrifice Isaac Considered God who promised is able to raise men from the dead God is able to accomplish all He promised All he spoke

Chapters 11: "Faith" **Considered God faithful to His** promise Looked impossible for her to have a son

Chapters 11: "Faith" God's promises went from Abraham to Isaac to Jacob Jacob's name changed to Israel

Chapters 11: "Faith" Freedom from Egypt Believed God's promise of land

Chapters 11: "Faith" Parents people of faith Protected him from death Not indulging in life's pleasures Enduring ill-treatment with people of God Heb. 10:32-24

Chapters 11: "Faith" Endurance is part of faith Leads to reward. Heb. 10:35-36 Led his people out of Egypt Not fearing the king

Chapters 11: "Faith" Example of endurance, diligence, confidence

Chapters 11: "Faith" Jericho was destroyed by faith of Joshua, Israel's leader Rahab also trusted God **Resident of Jericho**
