Part of the elementary teaching

Believers to press on to maturity

6:12

Believers are to imitate others

Who inherit the promises

Through faith and patience

Growing in faith is part of maturity

God who promised is faithful

Faith comes from God

He’s the source and example

Enoch

Did not die

Noah

Believed what God told him

About the coming judgment of flood

Righteous man lived by faith

Even in light of coming judgment

Abraham

Faith grew

From following God to a foreign land
To believing that God would give him
a son

Abraham

When tested to sacrifice Isaac

Considered God who promised is able
to raise men from the dead

God is able to accomplish all He
promised

All he spoke

Sarah

Considered God faithful to His
promise

Looked impossible for her to have a
son

Isaac, Jacob

God’s promises went from Abraham
to Isaac to Jacob

Jacob’s name changed to Israel

Freedom from Egypt

Believed God’s promise of land

Protected him from death

Not indulging in life’s pleasures
