- v. 5 an angel predicts John's birth to Zacharias.
  - Herod was king of Judea,
- v. 26 angel tells Mary that she'd bear a son.
  - In Elizabeth's sixth month

- v. 39 "The Visitation" and John leaps in his mother's womb.
  - "in those days"
    - Gabriel's visit
    - Elizabeth's sixth month

## Luke 1 – Major Events And Time Phrases

- v. 39 "The Visitation" and John leaps in his mother's womb.
  - "in those days" Gabriel's visit
- v. 57 John is born and circumcised.
  - Three months after Mary's visit...
    and Eight days after his birth.

## "Magnificat" – a focus on YHWH

- · He's "my savior." \*
- He has regard for the humble state of His "bond-slave."
- He is the "Mighty One." \*
- · He has done great things for her.
- · His name is Holy. \*
- He shows mercy to those who fear Him.

## "Magnificat" – a focus on YHWH

- He has scattered the proud. \*
- He brought down rulers.
- · He raised up those who were humble.\*
- He feeds the hungry and sends the rich away empty handed.\*
- · He has given help to Israel
- He spoke to the Fathers, Abraham and his "seed." \*

# By what she sang, what do we know about Mary?

- ·She knew the Scriptures.
- ·She is given to worship.
- ·She is humble and amazed that the Lord choose her.
- ·She is deeply dependent on YHWH.
- ·She sees her place in history.

## When Zacharias speaks, <u>according to</u> the text what is he doing?

In light of Genesis 17:9-14, why is this important?

- ·It was an act of obedience/worship.
- ·He was making a commitment to keep covenant with Elohim, into the next generation.

# What do you learn about God, only from Zacharias in these verses.

- v. 68 He is the God of Israel and has visited His people to bring them redemption.
- v. 69 He has brought salvation from their enemies as He promised.

# What do you learn about God, only from Zacharias in these verses.

vs. 70-71 — "As <u>He spoke by the</u> <u>mouth of His holy prophets</u> from of old—Salvation FROM OUR ENEMIES, and FROM THE HAND OF ALL WHO HATE US;

(verbal inspiration)

He was Adam's promised Seed, Abraham's Isaac, Jacob's Shiloh, Moses' Great Prophet, Isaiah's Immanuel, Ezekiel's Shepherd, Daniel's Holy One, Zechariah's Branch, Malachi's Angel; He was Abel's Sacrifice, Noah's Dove, Aaron's Rod, the Israelites' Rock, the Patriarchs' Manna, David's Tabernacle, Solomon's Temple

# What do you learn about God, only from Zacharias in these verses.

- v. 72 He was merciful to the Fathers, remembering His covenant with Abraham.
- v. 74 He rescued Israel from their enemies so that they might serve Him w/o fear.

#### How John related to Jesus Luke 1:16-17 cf. Mal. 3:1, 5-6

He would be the "Messenger," preparing the way before Him who was promised, in the spirit and power of Elijah, calling a people to repent and to be ready for the Lord's coming.
