3. Why does Jesus say He, the Son of Man, is Lord of the Sabbath? How does this relate to your life?
4. What are verses 6-11 about? How does the flow of thought continue from the beginning of the chapter? Does the response of the Pharisees remind you of a similar response in Chapter 4?
5. What happens in verses 12-16? What do you remember about disciples, and what is the definition of apostles? How are they different?
6. How does verse 12 relate to what Jesus did in verse 13?
7. Look at Luke 5:16. How does prayer apply to you?
8. What takes place in verses 17-19? Who wanted to be with Jesus, and why?
9. How does Luke 1-6 have meaning for people today? What was Jesus' ministry? Who is He? What does He do?
10. In Luke 6:20-26, to whom did Jesus direct His teaching? What did He teach them in general? Look for the primary contrast in this passage. Mark the key words in this passage (find them on your own.)
