1. What is the setting? And Who was Jesus talking to?
2. How did Jesus describe this group? Relate this to verse 16.
3. Jesus taught about what would happen to “this generation” using two illustrations using “the sign of Jonah” and the “Queen of the South”.

What do we learn from the Jonah illustration? You may want to read Jonah 1:1-17, Jonah 2:10, and Jonah 3:1-10 for context.

What do we see glean from Luke and the two cross-references?

Revelation 20:11-15**Matthew 12:38-41** (Also refer to Luke 9:22 and 9:51)

What do we learn from the “Queen of the South” illustration in verse 31?

4. The third illustration in verses 33-36 uses a lamp. What’s the message here?
5. How may this illustration apply to us today?

6. In this passage we have another interaction between Jesus and a Pharisee. What is the teaching that accompanied this dinner?

Compare with Mark 7:1-4

7. Jesus pronounces “woes” upon both the Pharisees and the Lawyers in verses 42-48, and 52. What were the issues that Jesus has against each group?

Woe to Pharisees

8. What did Jesus say about this in verses 49-51?

What do these verses say about Abel? Genesis 4:1-11 and Hebrews 11:4

What do these verses say about Zechariah? 2 Chronicles 24:17-21 and Zechariah 1:1
