It will be helpful for you to mark the following: Every reference to the disciples, including all pronouns References to the crowd References to *fear* in one way and *worry* in another way Every exhortation to be ready Any reference to the coming of the Son of Man, and the master's coming, if you think it is appropriate Mark beware—it's used twice in Luke 12. Mark all references to possessions, goods, treasure, money belts, being rich Remember, it is not the marking that is important. Rather, it is the intentional reading that is most beneficial. Verses 1-12 1. How did Jesus' first statement connect with the end of Luke 11? 2. What is the next warning in verses 4-7? 3. Do some research on "hell" or Gehenna and write what you learn. 4. How does Deuteronomy 32:39 relate to Luke 12:5? And Mt. 5:22, 29-30; 23:33? Is there a literal hell? 5. What is the contrast in verses 8-9? How does verse 10 fit with these verses?

6. What does Mark 3:28-30 say about forgiveness and blasphemy against the Holy Spirit?

7. How does the Holy Spirit aid the disciples in verses 11-12?
