To preach the kingdom of God

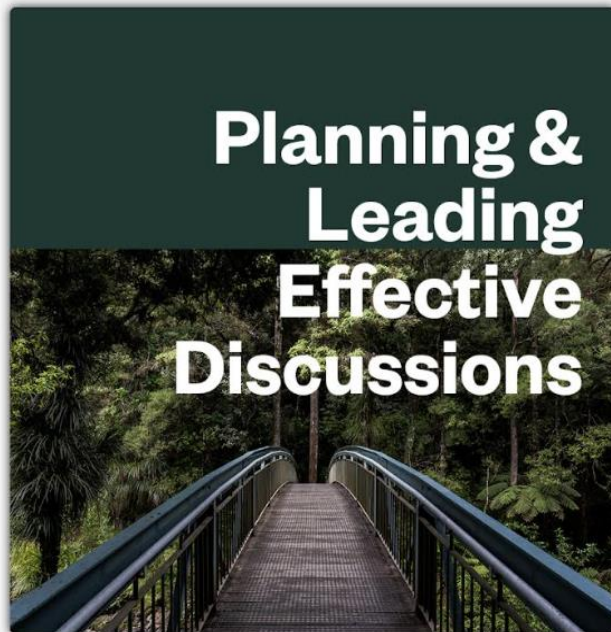
To call sinners to repentance

The peril

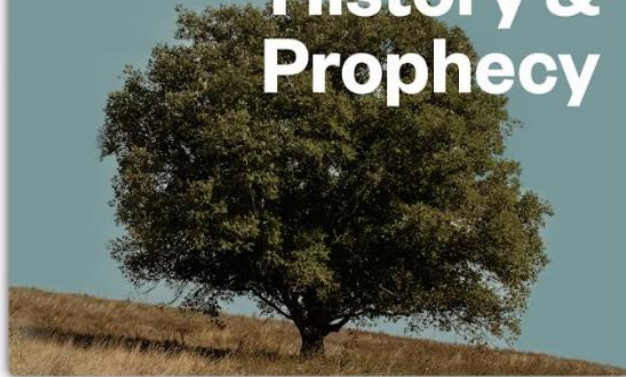

Refusing to forgive

Offending person apologizes

Luke 17:3-4

Procedure--1

Eph. 4:32

Wronged by another believer

Forgive in your heart

Keeps soul from

Resentment

Malice

Luke 17:3-4

Procedure--2

Luke 17:3; Mt. 18:15

Go to offender

Privately

Rebuke

Repent = forgiven

Sins repeatedly and repents = forgiven Lk. 17:4

Luke 17:3-4

Procedure--3

Mt. 18:16

Private rebuke ineffective

One wronged

Take 1 or 2 witnesses

Does not listen

Go to church

Failure to hear church = excommunication Mt. 18:17

Not revenge

Not humiliation

Restoration

Fellowship with Lord

Fellowship with believers

repentance?

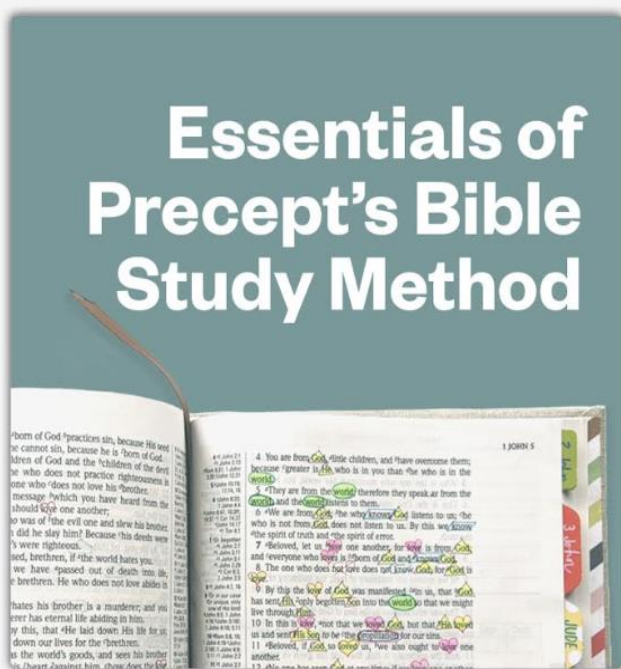
Genuine repentance?

Pride—root up and cast out

Samaritan woman surprised that
Jesus spoke with her

John 4:7-26

Samaritans?

Jews and Samaritans had different worship

Samaritans idolatry + Jehovah

Samaritans considered foreigners

Because of their history

2 Kings 17

Samaritans?

Samaria

Capital of northern kingdom of Israel

Jews took them captive 722 B.C.

Assyrians brought people from other nations to Samaria

[5-6] Peril of pride

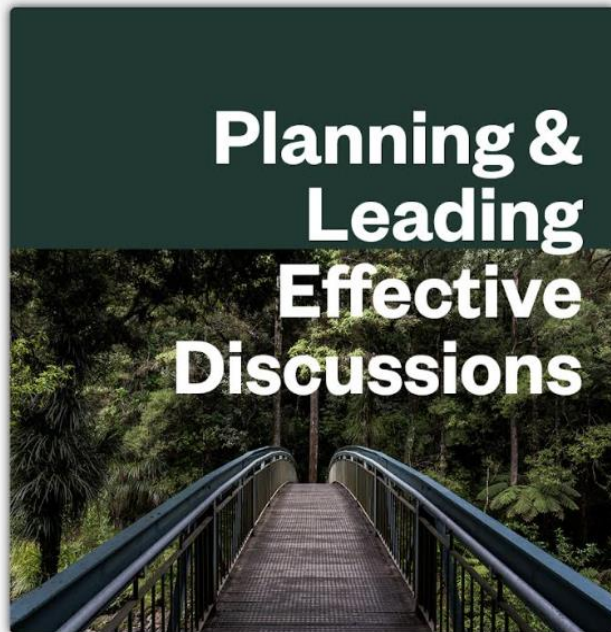
[7-10] Peril of worthiness
