## Garden of Gethsemane

Instructed disciples to pray

May not enter into temptation (40, 47)

Abandon Him when enemies close in

40-45

Mentioned 5 times

Align His will with the Father's

Pray, Withdrew, Knelt, Remove,

Strengthening

Peter mentioned in every verse

Fulfilling Jesus' words

3 denials

Lord turned, looked

Peter wept bitterly

# Jesus Imprisoned

63-65

The men

Jesus

mocked, beaten, blasphemed

Irony

Prophecy fulfilled

# Jesus Questioned: Mark 14:53-65

No reason for death

False testimony

Inconsistent

High Priest direct

Blasphemy

Tore robe

Deserving death

# Jesus Questioned

## Problem

Jews penalty for blasphemy = death

No authority for this under Romans

Appeal to Pilate

Religious? No.

Political? Yes.
