Herod in Jerusalem at that time

Herod's soldiers

Treated Jesus with contempt, mocking

Gorgeous robe

To Pilate

Herod, Pilate friends—united vs Jesus

# Luke 23:13-25

## Jesus before Pilate (again)

Pilate did not acquit

Trapped

Summoned chief priests et al

Neither he nor Herod ruled guilty

# Luke 23:13-25

## Jesus before Pilate (again)

Pilate's proposal

Whip and release

Sad compromise

Tried to do his duty by Jesus

Satisfy the crowd

# Luke 23:13-25

## Jesus before Pilate (again)

Did neither

Chief priests et al enraged

Demand release of Barnabas

Death of Jesus

Pilate tried to exonerate Jesus

# Luke 23:13-25

## Jesus before Pilate (again)

Mt.

Already pronounced Jesus innocent

Now condemned Jesus to death

Released Barabbas

Please the people

Jesus before Pilate (again)

Mt. 27:15-30

Pilate's wife

Have nothing to do with righteous man

Dream—she suffered greatly

# Luke 23:13-25

Jesus before Pilate (again)

Mt. 27:15-30

Pilate what to do with Jesus

Accomplishing nothing

Washed his hands

Innocent of His blood

Miscarriage of justice

Crowd

Crucify Him

Blood on them, children

Does history prove this?

# Luke 23:13-25

**Mt. 27:15-30**

Jesus scourged then to be crucified

Soldiers

Stripped Him

Put on scarlet robe

# Luke 23:13-25

**Mt. 27:15-30**

Crown of thorns

We wear crown of glory

Reed in right hand

Knelt before Him, mocked

King of Sin. We worship Him as Savior of Sinners.

Spat on Him

Took the reed, beat Him

# Luke 23:26-49

Led to the cross

**People/groups of people involved**

Simon carried the cross

Sanhedrin plot for cross

People mourning

Criminals conflicted

Soldiers crucified Jesus, cast lots, mocked, sour wine

Rulers sneering
