Review:

1. What events caused the church to spread throughout Judea and Samaria?
2. In our study so far, who is the prominent figure, and how was he used to grow the church?

Acts 11:1-18

1. What issue did Peter face when he came to Jerusalem after being in Caesarea? Who is it that had concerns?
2. Why do the details which Peter gives of his visit to Cornelius help support his actions?
3. What interesting details does Peter add which were not given in the previous chapter? Which detail helps us understand Cornelius' relationship with Jesus prior to Peter's visit?
4. How long did it take after Peter's message to Cornelius and the others for the Holy Spirit to act? (Acts 10:44)
5. What do we learn about baptism in verse 16? What event was Peter reminded of?
6. What did Peter call the Gentiles to do? Why? What should we think had already happened in the hearts of these Gentiles? (Acts 10:34-35)
7. What are the terms that describe what happened to the Gentiles?

8. What do you learn about Peter from Matthew 16:13-20? How do we see Peter being used in the book of Acts? How does this fit with Acts 9:15? (Acts 2:1-21, 37-42; 8:4-25; Acts 10)

Acts 11:19-30

1. What is happening with the gospel? To whom first? (Rom. 1:16)
2. Who was sent to Antioch? What was the result? And who was recruited?
3. What did Agabus prophesy? Did it happen?
4. When did these events happen? Was this before or after the conversion of Cornelius?
5. What action followed that showed the unity of the early church?
