7. Paul and his companions travel to what location and what happens to John Mark along the way? (13:14)

8. What happened during Paul & Barnabas' first synagogue visit in Pisidia? (13:14–41)

9. How did people respond to the message Paul preached? (13:42–43)

10. What happened on the next Sabbath? (13:44–48)

11. How did the Gentiles respond to the Word of the Lord? (13:48-49)

12. What price did Paul and Barnabas pay for telling people about Christ? (13:50-52)

13. What did you learn from verse 52 and the cross-references about the disciples?
Luke 14:26-33 and Mark 10:28-30 and John 8:31

14. How was this lived out by the disciples in Acts? Are Jesus' statements about His disciples still relevant for believers today?

15. How does Acts 13 illustrate the importance of the Holy Spirit in the ministry of Paul and Barnabas?

16. What practices or habits can we adopt to discern the Holy Spirit's leading in our decision-making just as Paul and Barnabas did?
