**Review:**

1. Who was the first apostle to preach specifically to the Gentiles? Why was this ironic?
2. How was Paul's message to the Jews in Antioch in Pisidia similar to Peter's message in Acts 2?

Acts 14:1-7

1. Where did Paul and Barnabas go after being in Antioch in Pisidia? Why?
2. What happened in Iconium?
3. Define "signs" and "wonders" as used in Acts 14:3. What is the Lord doing here?
4. Where did Paul and Barnabas go next? Why?

Acts 14:8-18

1. What happened at Lystra? What do we learn about Paul? How might that relate to our lives in Christ?
2. How did the crowd respond? Do we know why they named Paul and Barnabas as they did?
3. What peril, greater than persecution, did Paul and Barnabas face in Lystra? What happened next?
4. Did God allow the Gentiles in earlier years to ignore Him? How does Romans 1:18-20 connect with this?

Acts 14:19-23

1. What dramatic change occurred next, and why?
2. What happened to Paul? Reference 2 Cor. 12:2.
3. How do we know that Paul and Barnabas were not primarily concerned about their safety?
4. Who might have been a witness to these events in Lystra?  
Reference Acts 16:1, 2.
5. Why did the missionaries (Paul and Barnabas) return to Lystra, Iconium, and Antioch? Reference Col. 1:28, 29.

2. What do most of the preachings in Acts have in common; i.e. who was guiding the men, and what prompted them?
