3. What epistle did Paul likely write from Macedonia? (2 Cor. 9:2-4)
4. Where did Paul go from Macedonia? How long did he spend there? What epistle(s) did he write while in this place? (Rom. 15:15-33)
5. What changed Paul's travel plans?
6. What cities/regions were the people from in Acts 20:4? Who joined Paul in Philippi?
