2. From Miletus where did they travel? (21:1-3)
  
3. At Tyre, how long did they stay and what did the disciples there advise Paul to do? (21:4)
  
4. Why did Paul ignore the believers' warning?
  
5. How was the departure scene at Tyre meaningful? (21:5-6)
  
6. What did the group do on their one-day stop in Ptolemais? (21:7)
  
7. Who was Paul's host in Caesarea and what was his role in the early church? (21:8) Also see Acts 6:5, 8:4-13, and 8:26-40.
  
8. What gift did Philip's four daughters have? (21:9) Also see how this fits with the promise of Joel 2:28-29 (cited in Acts 2:17-18).
  
9. Who was Agabus and where did Agabus come from and what did he prophesy concerning Paul? (21:10-12)

10. What did Paul say to the Christians at Caesarea? (21:13–14) When they realized that Paul would not be dissuaded, what did the believers say to him?

11. What did Paul and his companions do on the final stage of their journey? (21:15–16)

### **Verses 17-26 Paul visits James and the Church Elders**

12. On their second day in Jerusalem who did Paul go see and what did Paul report? (21:18-19)

13. What concern did the church leaders voice? (21:20-21)

14. What did the leaders of the church suggest that Paul do? Why? (21:22–24)

15. Why did the leaders bring up the Jerusalem decree? (21:25)

16. What did Paul and the young men do the next day? (21:26)

### **Verses 27-36 Paul Arrested in the Temple**

17. What happened when Paul went to the temple? (21:27-30)

18. What was at the heart of the controversy between the Jews and the Gentiles?

19. What happens when the Roman commander / tribune (court official) heard what was going on? (21:31-36)
