10. What was the response of Governor Felix this time? What were his motives? (If you can research anything about Felix, it may add some depth to your answer.)
  
11. How much time passes from the time Paul is sent to Governor Felix until the Governors change?
  
12. Festus replaced Felix as Governor/Procurator of Palestine. Did Festus tend to be more or less favorable toward Paul's Jewish accusers? Why do you think so?
  
13. What significant change does Paul make in his defense to Festus, in comparison with his defense before Felix? Why do you think he made this change?
  
14. Of what prejudice does Paul boldly accuse Governor Festus?
  
15. In 25:11 Paul is fearless of death, even death in Rome. To what do you attribute this fearlessness?
