1. What was the second miracle that took place? What came about afterward?
2. How did these events help the sailors?

Acts 28:11-15

1. How long were Paul and his cohorts in Malta?
2. What encouraged Paul?

Acts 28:16

1. How was Paul imprisoned in Rome? Was this unusual?

Acts 28:17-22

1. What did Paul begin to do? Was this expected?
2. How did the “brethren” respond?

Acts 28:23-29

1. What was Paul’s message? Was his message successful?
2. Why did Paul quote Isaiah? How does this compare with Romans 11?
3. Why did Paul mention the Gentiles’ reception of the gospel?

Acts 28:30-31

1. What do we learn about Paul’s stay in Rome?
2. Was God faithful to His promise to Paul? (Acts 19:21; 23:11; Eph. 2:10)
3. What epistles did Paul write during this time?
4. How was Paul’s preaching of the kingdom of God different in Rome?
5. How does Phil. 1:7-26 relate to this time in Paul’s life? Do you share a similar life perspective?
