“Man” or “Son of Man”?

*When God created mankind “in His Image,” what was God’s intention for mankind in relation to creation?*

*Genesis 1:26-30*



*Then God said, “Let Us make man in Our image... and let them rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky and over the cattle and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.” God created man in His own image... male and female He created them. God blessed them; and God said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth, and subdue it..”*
