

Hebrews 2:17 -- The <u>first</u> that Hebrews speaks about Jesus as our Great High Priest

He is a merciful and faithful priest of things pertaining to GOD

He made propitiation for the sins of the people

Hebrews 3:1 -- What insights do we gain here about Jesus as our Great High Priest

He is the Apostle and High Priest of our confession

How is He the one in whom we hold fast to confidence and on whom base our confession

Hebrews 4:14 -16 -- What else do we learn here about Jesus as our Great High Priest

He is the great High Priest who has passed through the heavens.

He can sympathize with our weaknesses because he has been tempted as we are, yet without sin.

As you look at both 4:14-16 and 2:17-18, do you see them as more of a comparison or a contrast?

Hebrews 5:5-10 -- What else do we learn here about Jesus as our Great High Priest

He didn't claim the priest's role on His own; He was appointed by God as both a Son and a Priest.

As an obedient Priest, He was also a perfect source of eternal salvation.

THE POINT! Jesus is the one we have confessed as the Son of God and High priest, sent by God ("Apostle" 3:1). We are to hold fast to that initial confession and draw near boldly to His throne of grace for forgiveness of our sins.

What is your 10-word summary of Hebrews 5.

As God's appointed High Priest, Jesus' sacrifice earned eternal salvation.

Exodus 28-29 - What did you discover about the Old Testament Priests - Aaron and his sons? God called Aaron and his sons as priests. They were to minister to God Aaron was to dress a certain way, in holy garments specified by God, for glory and beauty.

Exodus 28-29 - What did you discover about the Old Testament Priests - Aaron and his sons?

As part of Aaron's garments, he wore stones to represent the twelve tribes of Israel. Therefore, their names were on his shoulders and over his heart, as memorials before the Lord continually

Exodus 28-29 - What did you discover about the Old Testament Priests - Aaron and his sons?

For decisions the "Urim & Thummin"
were carried in the breast piece, called the
Breastpiece of Judgement.
Aaron and his sons were anointed,
ordain, and consecrated, with their
garments, to serve God as priests.

Exodus 28-29 - What did you discover about the Old Testament Priests - Aaron and his sons?

God, through Moses, established the 7-day ceremony by which one of Aaron's sons would be anointed and ordained as the high priest.



Hebrews 5:3-4 - Only those appointed by God could offer sacrifices for sins of the people.

Aaron and his sons! (period!!!)

Not: descendants of other sons of Levi -

- ·Levi's sons: Gershon, Kohath and Merari.
- · Parents of Moses and Aaron, both Levites.
- ·BUT. Moses could NOT offer sacrifices!

Numbers 16:1-18:7- When someone not descended of Aaron wanted to make sacrifices...

Korah, a Levite, grumbled against Moses

→ Was not a priest + no land in Canaan.

Dathan & Abiram = Rubenites

Earthquake killed 250+ & 14,700 by plague

"All Priests were Levites, but NOT all Levites were Priests"

What was the significance of BUDS & Almonds springing out of Aaron's staff?

Of what Tribe was Jesus?.

Hebrews 5:1-6 - Since Jesus was of the Tribe of Judah, rather than Levi, how did He become High Priest

According to Psalm 2:7 and 110:4, Jesus, God's Son was appointed a "Priest forever," by God Himself, after to the Order of Melchizedek.

Hebrews 5:5-10 - What do we learn here about Jesus, God's Son? Compare this with Hebrews 5:1-2?

As the Son, He was the Father's means of creating the world and was appointed heir of all things.

After studying Hebrews 4:14-5:10, how does knowing Jesus as your high priest affect your life.

Whose High Priest is He?
