B. Brief on Programme and Preparation

- 1. Programme Aims:
 - a. Deepen and broaden relationships with each other for life together as a church.
 - b. Come together to paint a picture of what GBC will look like as we live out the Gospel together.
- 2. Pray that God will bless the camp.
- 3. Prepare to share in small group:
 - a. Short testimony of when and how you came to be a Christian.
 - b. A high and a low point in your life in the last 6 months.
 - c. Prayer points to pray with different group each day.
 - d. How you would like to see the church grow in living out Gospel together.
- 4. Read following passages from the Bible: Romans 12:1-21, 1 Peter 4:1-19.
- 5. Create WhatsApp Group for admin and coordination for Camp Groups.

C. Immigration

- 1. Validity of passports: Minimum 6 months (expiry after 16 Dec 2019)
- 2. Ensure passport is stamped at Malaysian immigration (both entry and exit)

- 3. Visa not required for most nationalities (see table of countries requiring visas).
- 4. Immigration cards: No longer required for Causeway.

D. Travel Insurance

1. Package includes personal accident insurance of \$10,000. Do consider getting additional travel insurance of your own.

E. Personal Items to Bring

- 1. **Medication for chronic conditions** (eg. asthma inhalers, blood pressure) and common medication (eg. diarrhoea, anti-allergy, fever & sore throat)
- 2. Insect repellent and cream for insect bites (may have sand flies in June)
- 3. Sunblock
- 4. Clothing for 4 days & 3 nights
- 5. Attire and shoes for outdoor recreational activities (2 afternoons)
- 6. Swim wear and sandals for pool
- 7. Water bottle to stay hydrated
- 8. Toiletries and personal grooming kit (hotel shampoo and soap provided)
- 9. Bible (hardcopy or offline) and stationery
- 10. Phone charger
- 11. Torchlight (optional)
- 12. Umbrella (optional)
- 13. Credit cards and Malaysian Ringgit for purchase of drinks/snacks at resort or nearby shops; and lunch/shopping stop on the way back. Suggest at least RM 200.

F. Snacks & Drinks

- 1. Snacks and drinks may be purchased at resort store or nearby shops.
- 2. Bring your own coffee if you must have good coffee.
- 3. Boil tap water before drinking.
- 4. Room has kitchenette with kettle, refrigerator and microwave.
- 5. No cooking allowed in rooms (hotel rules).

G. Safety

- 1. No swimming in the sea (strong currents).
- 2. Sea sports is discouraged for your own safety.
- 3. Stay hydrated.

H. Camp Doctors

1. Drs Gerald Chua and Siew Jo Keow. Please inform them of any existing medical conditions if necessary.

I. Wifi and Data Roaming

- 1. Free wifi at resort. Wifi speed is good in rooms.
- 2. 1 GB Data Roaming from \$5-10, depending on your service provider.

DEPARTURE ON 12 JUNE 2019

J. Coach from Church to Resort

- 1. Meet in church by 8:00am. Bus will leave at 8:30am sharp.
- 2. You will be gathered to board bus according to Bus Manifest. Check your name and details are correct on Bus Manifest.
- 3. Journey will take about 2 hours. There will be 1 toilet break at SG checkpoint. Arrival at Lotus Desaru expected around 11:00am.
- 4. Bring some water and snacks on board bus in case of hunger/thirst.

- 5. Please visit the toilet before departure especially children.
- 6. Bus I/C(s) to ensure:
 - a. Correct headcount at departure, before leaving customs and rest stops.
 - b. Coach luggage compartment door is closed especially after clearing Malaysian customs.

K. Parking at GBC

1. For those leaving their cars in GBC, park at 2nd level. Shutter gates will be closed after.

L. Driving

- 1. Check car coolant level, tyre pressure and spare tyre.
- 2. Ensure petrol tank is 3/4 full at Singapore customs.
- 3. Speed limit on Malaysian highways is 110 km/h.
- 4. Travel via Woodlands Checkpoint is shortest but may take longer depending on jam at Causeway. Second Link at Tuas has smoother traffic but distance is 40 km longer. Best to check traffic conditions before setting off (Download "Beat the Jam" iPhone/Android App)
- 5. "Touch 'n Go" card is needed to pay for tolls for Malaysian Immigration and along the way to the resort.
- 6. Toll charges both ways approx. RM50.

M. Purchase/Top-up the "Touch 'n Go" card at the following locations

- 1. Self Service Kiosk (vending machines) before Immigration in Johor Bahru (RM only).
- 2. Can top up at some toll booth with words "TAMBAH NILAI" (RM only), or 7-Eleven, Watsons & Shell petrol stations. See touchngo.com.my for more info.

- 1. Arrive by 11:15am latest
- 2. Free parking is available at the resort (uncovered).
- 3. Proceed directly to Ballroom with luggage. Welcome drinks provided there.
- 4. Camp Opening at 11:30am in Ballroom.
- 5. Lunch is provided at the resort's Seaview Restaurant after the briefing.
- 6. Check-in is from 2 to 3 pm in ballroom.
