Lost in wonder love and praise

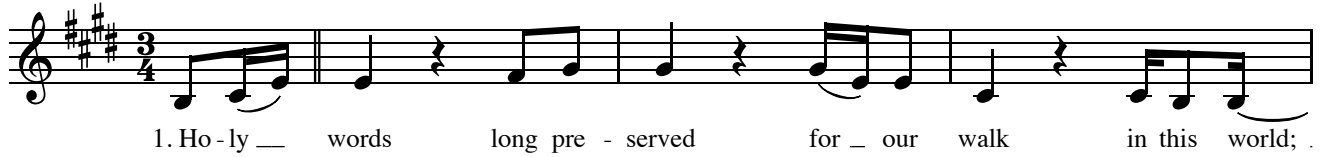
