# **Public Reading of Scripture**

**Judges 6:19-27** 

(Lectio Continua – the practice of reading Scripture in sequence)

Scripture context:

The angel of the Lord, very likely a theophany, has appeared to Gideon to instruct him on what to do as the next judge of Israel

So Gideon went into his house and prepared a young goat and unleavened cakes from an ephah of flour. The meat he put in a basket, and the broth he put in a pot, and brought them to him under the terebinth and presented them. <sup>20</sup> And the angel of God said to him, "Take the meat and the unleavened cakes, and put them on this rock, and pour the broth over them." And he did so. <sup>21</sup> Then the angel of the LORD reached out the tip of the staff that was in his hand and touched the meat and the unleavened cakes. And fire sprang up from the rock and consumed the flesh and the unleavened cakes. And the angel of the LORD vanished from his

sight. <sup>22</sup> Then Gideon perceived that he was the angel of the LORD. And Gideon said, "Alas, O Lord GOD! For now I have seen the angel of the LORD face to face." <sup>23</sup> But the LORD said to him, "Peace be to you. Do not fear; you shall not die."
