Call to Worship

from Psalm 29

- Pastor: Ascribe to the Lord, O mighty ones, ascribe to the Lord glory and strength.
- People: Ascribe to the Lord glory due his name; worship the Lord in the splendor of his holiness.
- Pastor: The voice of the Lord is over the waters; the God of glory thunders, the Lord thunders over the mighty waters.

People: The voice of the Lord is powerful; the voice of the Lord is majestic.

Pastor: The voice of the Lord breaks the cedars; the Lord breaks in pieces the cedars of Lebanon.

Public Confession of Sin

All: O Lord, I am deeply convinced of the evil and misery of my sinful condition, of the vanity of creatures, but also of the sufficiency of Christ. When You would guide me, I control myself. When You would be sovereign, I rule myself. When you would take care of me, I suffice myself. When I should depend on Your provision, I supply myself. When I should submit to Your providence, I follow my will. When I should study, love, honor and trust You, I serve myself. I fault and correct Your law to suit myself, and I am by nature an idolater. Take away my roving eye, curious ear, greedy appetite and lustful heart. Take away whatever keeps me

from loving You with all my heart, mind and strength; and forgive me for not loving my neighbor as I ought. Amen.

Corporate Confession of Faith – Apostles' Creed

I believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth.
I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, and born of the virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended into hell.* The third day he rose again from the dead. Judges 7:19-25

Scripture Context:

Gideon defeats the Midianites.

So Gideon and the hundred men who were with him came to the outskirts of the camp at the beginning of the middle watch, when they had just set the watch. And they blew the trumpets and smashed the jars that were in their hands. ²⁰ Then the three companies blew the trumpets and broke the jars. They held in their left hands the torches, and in their right hands the trumpets to blow. And they cried out, "A sword for the LORD and for Gideon!" ²¹ Every man stood in his place around the camp, and all the army ran. They cried out and fled.²² When they blew the 300 trumpets, the LORD set every man's sword against his comrade and against all the army. And the army fled as far as Beth-shittah toward Zererah,¹ as far as the border of Abel-meholah, by Tabbath.²³ And the men of Israel were called out from Naphtali and from Asher and from all Manasseh, and they pursued after Midian. ²⁴ Gideon sent messengers throughout all the hill country of Ephraim, saying, "Come down against the Midianites and capture the waters against them, as far as Beth-barah, and also the Jordan." So all the men of Ephraim were called out, and they captured the waters as far as Beth-barah, and also the Jordan.²⁵ And they captured the two princes of Midian, Oreb and Zeeb. They killed Oreb at the rock of Oreb, and Zeeb they killed at the winepress of Zeeb. Then they pursued Midian, and they brought the heads of Oreb and Zeeb to Gideon across the Jordan.
