1 Samuel 1:12-20

(Lectio Continua – the practice of reading Scripture in sequence)

Scripture context:

Hannah's longsuffering and faith are rewarded as God grants her prayer of faith

As she continued praying before the LORD, Eli observed her mouth. ¹³ Hannah was speaking in her heart; only her lips moved, and her voice was not heard. Therefore Eli took her to be a drunken woman. ¹⁴ And Eli said

to her, "How long will you go on being drunk? Put away your wine from you."¹⁵ But Hannah answered, "No, my lord, I am a woman troubled in spirit. I have drunk neither wine nor strong drink, but I have been pouring out my soul before the LORD.¹⁶ Do not regard your servant as a worthless woman, for all along I have been speaking out of my great anxiety and vexation."¹⁷ Then Eli answered, "Go in peace, and the God of Israel grant your petition that you have made to him."¹⁸ And she said, "Let your servant find favor in your eyes." Then the woman went her way and ate, and her face was no longer sad.¹⁹ They rose early in the morning and worshiped before the LORD; then they went back to their house at Ramah. And Elkanah knew Hannah his wife, and the LORD remembered her.²⁰ And in due time Hannah conceived and bore a son, and she called his name Samuel, for she said, "I have asked for him from the LORD."¹

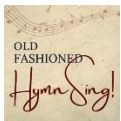
All Fairfield Ladies are invited to a short “Mark Your Calendars” Meeting immediately after morning worship, today, Feb. 15th, in Room 3.
