1. Are we, as individuals or as a church, in danger of honoring religious traditions and rules more than showing compassion to people? How do people today show the same self-righteous attitude of the Pharisees in Luke 13? What is the result?

2. At times, does it seem as if the world is prevailing over God’s kingdom? What evidence do you have that the kingdom is growing? Share your experiences or some stories of believers around the world.

3. What group of people today could possibly be outside the ‘door’ knocking when they think they’ve already entered (Luke 13:25)? What circumstances of a person’s life might indicate a danger of being turned away from the door? How do we help people in such situations?

4. Do you truly believe that the Lord will supernaturally empower your witness (see Acts 1:8)? How often do you show your compassion for others by sharing the gospel with the world? How will you and your group explain the nature of God’s Kingdom to unbelievers?
