And I stand on ev'ry promise of Your Word.







Why? Because you have...

1. *Come to Mount Mercy, not Misery (18-24a)*
2. *Heard a better word (24b-25)*
3. *Received an unshakable kingdom (26-29)*

1. To separate us from the love of God.

Romans 8:35-39

35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword?

36 As it is written, "For your sake we are being killed all the day long; we are regarded as sheep to be slaughtered."

37 No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.

Romans 8:35-39

38 For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers,

39 nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

1. To separate us from the love of God.

2. That God does not design for our holiness and peace.

Hebrews 12:9-10

9 Besides this, we have had earthly fathers who disciplined us and we respected them. Shall we not much more be subject to the Father of spirits and live?

35 But love your enemies, and do good, and lend, *expecting nothing in return*, and *your reward will be great*, and you will be sons of the Most High, for he is kind to the ungrateful and the evil.

36 Be merciful, even as your Father is merciful.
