Weekend Reflection

This Sunday is Resurrection Sunday! We celebrate that our Hope is alive. Jesus is risen! This is the most wonderful, life-giving truth for believers. We can see this even in our Bible reading this week.

Psalm 89:3-4 refers to the covenant that God made with David. Note what it says in verse four: "I will establish your offspring *forever* and build your throne for *all generations*." This is a promise that the Lord made to David!

How does God fulfill this promise? Is David's offspring established forever, and his throne for all generations? Indeed! This promise (as every promise of God) finds its "yes and amen in Christ". God has done this in Christ, and his death and RESURRECTION.

Take some time to marvel at God's amazing grace, demonstrated by the cross; and his amazing, triumphant power, which we see in his resurrection. Jesus is alive! Our King is alive. *His throne is established forever!*
