Next Sunday Sermon Questions

Next **Sunday, September 20**, we will be in **John 16:16-24**. Please read the passage this week and come ready to hear and receive God's Word.

- Why was it so difficult for the disciples to understand what Jesus was saying to them? (vv. 16-18)
- "Jesus knew that they wanted to ask him..." (v. 19) What does this teach us about Christ's divinity?
- Jesus turns their sorrow to joy (v. 20). How have you experienced Jesus meeting you in your sorrow?
- Jesus' resurrection brought an unshakeable joy to the disciples (v. 22). How has the Gospel given you this joy?
- Why does Jesus say, "You will ask nothing of me"? (v. 23)
- What does it mean to ask in Jesus' name? Will the Father really give us whatever we ask for? (vv. 23-24)
- What does Jesus mean when He says that their joy would be full if they would "ask and receive"? (v. 24)
- How can we as a Faith Group be encouraging one another this week to be more faithful in prayer?
