## SUNDAY SERMON

Next Sunday, April 26, the sermon will focus on John 15:1-11. Set aside time this week to read the passage and prepare yourself to hear God's Word.

## FAITH GROUPS

- In verses 1-2, what do the images of the "vine," the "vinedresser," and the "branches" teach us about our relationship to Jesus and the Father?
- Jesus says the Father "takes away" unfruitful branches and "prunes" fruitful ones (v.2). How do you understand these two actions?
- Verse 3 says the disciples are already "clean" because of Jesus' word. What does that suggest about how God cleanses and prepares believers to bear fruit?
- "Abide in me" is repeated throughout the passage (vv. 4-10). What does abiding look like practically in an ordinary week (habits, priorities, decisions, relationships)?
- What kinds of "fruit" do you think John 15 has in view (character, obedience, witness, love, service, disciples made)?
