## SUNDAY SERMON

On Sunday, May 10, we'll be preaching from 2 Timothy 1:1-7. Please plan to read the passage during the week ahead and come ready to receive God's Word.

## FAITH GROUPS

- Paul calls Timothy his "beloved child." What does this reveal about spiritual parenthood and the kind of encouragement younger believers need?
- Verse 5 highlights Timothy's "sincere faith" and traces it through his grandmother Lois and his mother Eunice. What does this teach about how faith is often passed on through family relationships and everyday influence?
- Thinking about Lois and Eunice (v. 5), what practices tend to cultivate "sincere faith" in the next generation—both inside and outside the home?
- Verse 7 says God gave us a spirit "not of fear but of power and love and self-control." Which of these three do you most need right now, and why?
- Motherhood can involve fear, fatigue, and uncertainty. How does verse 7 reshape the way we face those pressures, and what practical step can you take this week to walk in power, love, and self-control?
