1. Choose a time and place that is free from distractions.
  2. Ask God to speak to you through the reading of the passage.
  3. Read the passage in its entirety.
  4. Reread portions that are difficult to understand.
  5. Identify and review major points, and applications.
  6. Record in one or two sentences what God said to you through His Word.
  7. As you read through the passages each day, ask yourself, "What is the text saying?" and "How should I respond?"
  8. Challenge yourself to memorize the verses highlighted throughout the book.
