A FOUNDATIONAL PROBLEM

Insecure is defined as:

- 1. deficient in assurance; beset by fear and anxiety
- 2. not confident or sure; uncertain
- 3. not adequately guarded or sustained; unsafe
- 4. not firmly fastened or fixed; shaky

Questions to Consider Your Foundation:

- What makes you feel confident? A relationship? Your looks? Your bank account? Your intellect? Your success? Your status?
- What makes you feel unsettled, shaky, precarious? Any of those same things?

Shrub: small, low, weak; sapless and useless; barren and unfruitful; naked, made bare, destitute; lacks all the means of subsistence; total want of the means of life Interpretation: a person barren of solid comfort for the present and destitute of well-grounded hopes for the future; incapable of producing fruit	Tree: strength, stability, life Interpretation: a righteous man who is deeply rooted in God's Word, firmly grounded in faith, and drawing sustenance and strength from a divine source Planted: intentional placement and care
