

# PRAYER GUIDE

**“for I knew that you are a gracious God and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love, and relenting from disaster.” — Jonah 4:2**

## *Pray for* **A YES TO GOD'S CALL**

Jonah 1:1–3

Jonah ran from God's call. We often do too.

Pray for students to hear God clearly and be courageous enough to say “yes.”

Prayer Prompts:

- That students would surrender their will to God.
- That fears and distractions would be removed.
- That leaders would set an example of obedience and joy.

## *Pray for* **WAKE UP CALLS**

Jonah 1:4–17

God uses storms to bring us back.

Pray that nothing is wasted, even the hard stuff.

Prayer Prompts:

- For students to recognize where God is working, even in difficulties.
- That students would experience the presence of God in worship and teaching.
- That students would confess and turn from distractions and sin.

## *Pray for* **BROKEN HEARTS**

Jonah 2:1–10

God hears even our desperate whispers.

Pray for real encounters with God through brokenness and prayer.

Prayer Prompts:

- That students would come to God in honesty and vulnerability.
- For the Holy Spirit to work powerfully during quiet times and teaching.
- That students who feel alone or overwhelmed would experience God's rescue.

## *Pray for* **REPENTANCE FROM SIN**

Jonah 3:1–10

Jonah got another shot. So do we.

Pray for boldness, repentance, and surrender.

Prayer Prompts:

- That students would step into their calling with faith.
- For leaders to model grace and boldness.
- That revival would break out among the group like in Nineveh.

## *Pray for* **RENEWED LOVE FOR THE LOST**

Jonah 4:1–11

God's love reaches even those we'd overlook.

Pray for students to embrace God's heart for "the least of these."

Prayer Prompts:

- That students would see people through God's eyes—especially those who are hurting.
- For a spirit of compassion and service to grow.
- That every student would go home changed and ready to love boldly.
