We want to **ask the Lord to open the eyes of students to see how they are living in darkness.** Fro some students, it means that they need to see their lostness and turn to Jesus as Savior, Lord and Life. For others, this will mean they need the light of Christ to shine into their life to see ways they are living in darkness rather walking in the light. (John 8:12)



There is a light that drives away darkness. A light that drives out fear. A light that runs off despair. A light that shines for justice. A light that is comforting, and clarifying . . . A light that saves. His name is Jesus! He overcomes! Many students struggle with their sin, the lies they believe, the broken world around them and so much more. **Ask the Lord to prove Himself the victor in their lives.** These students need to know AND experience Jesus overcoming the darkness in their lives.
