VISION

MISSION

To remodel and renew the following main areas:

- **Infrastructure**- new HVAC in main buildings, brick work, fire sprinkler expansion
- **Worship Center**- flooring, Audio/Visual/Lighting (AVL), balcony, staging, etc.
- **Lobby + North Entrance**- restructuring the main entrance, reworking transition space, adding new bathrooms, eliminating steps, adding a new transition to the balcony, etc.
- **South Entrance**- reworking the ramp and entryway
- **Signage**- interior and exterior

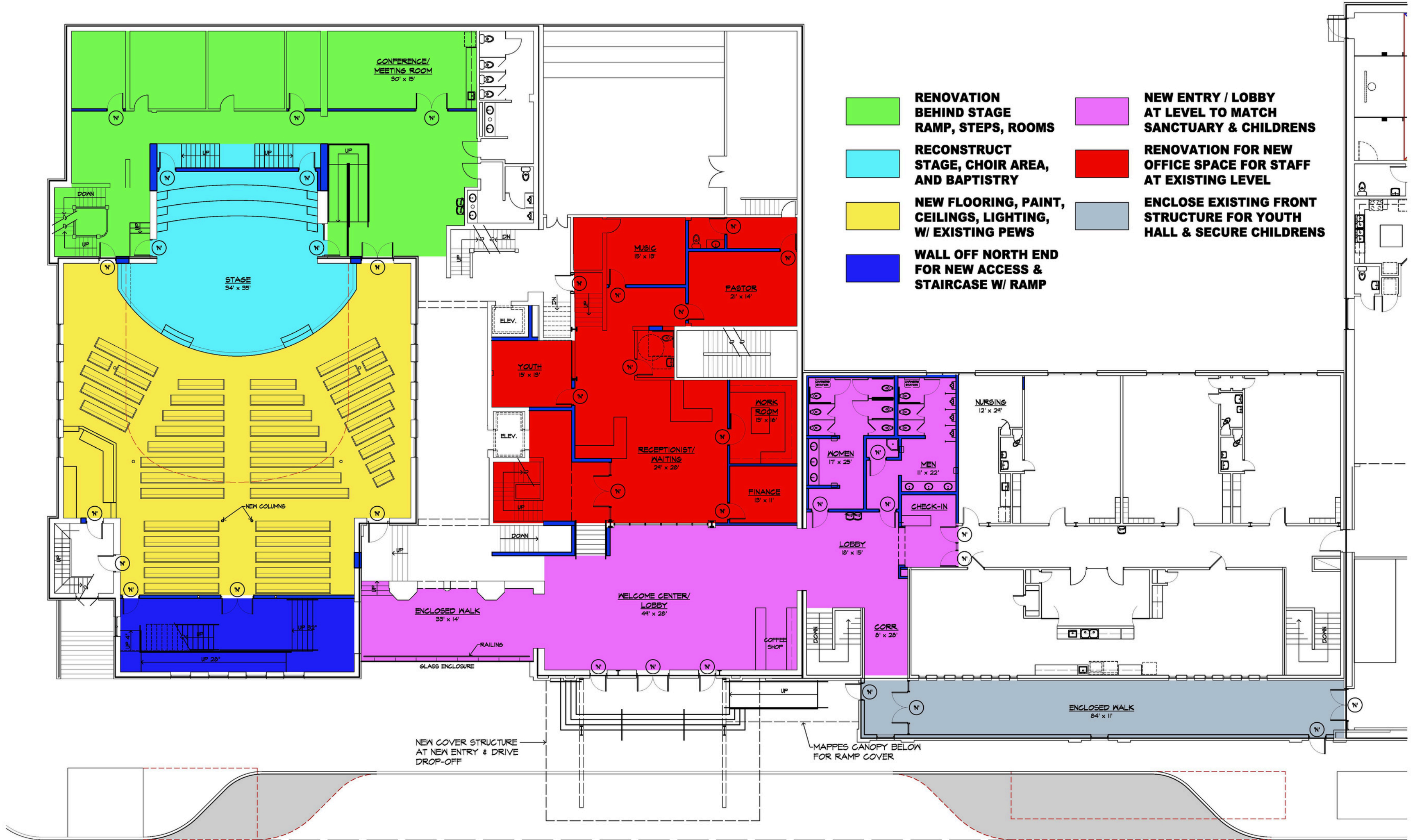
Rendering of Worship Center Remodel: Stage View from Main Level

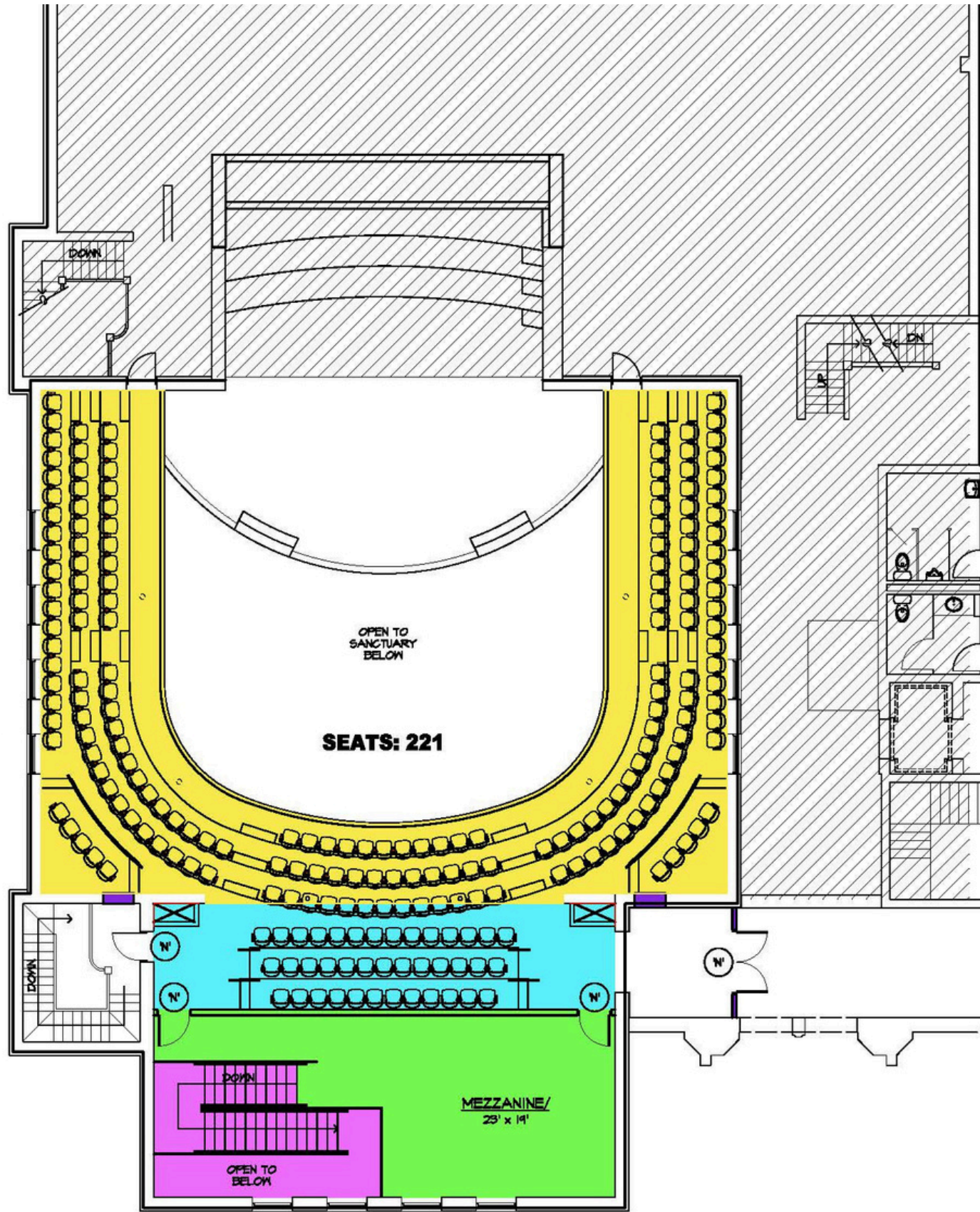




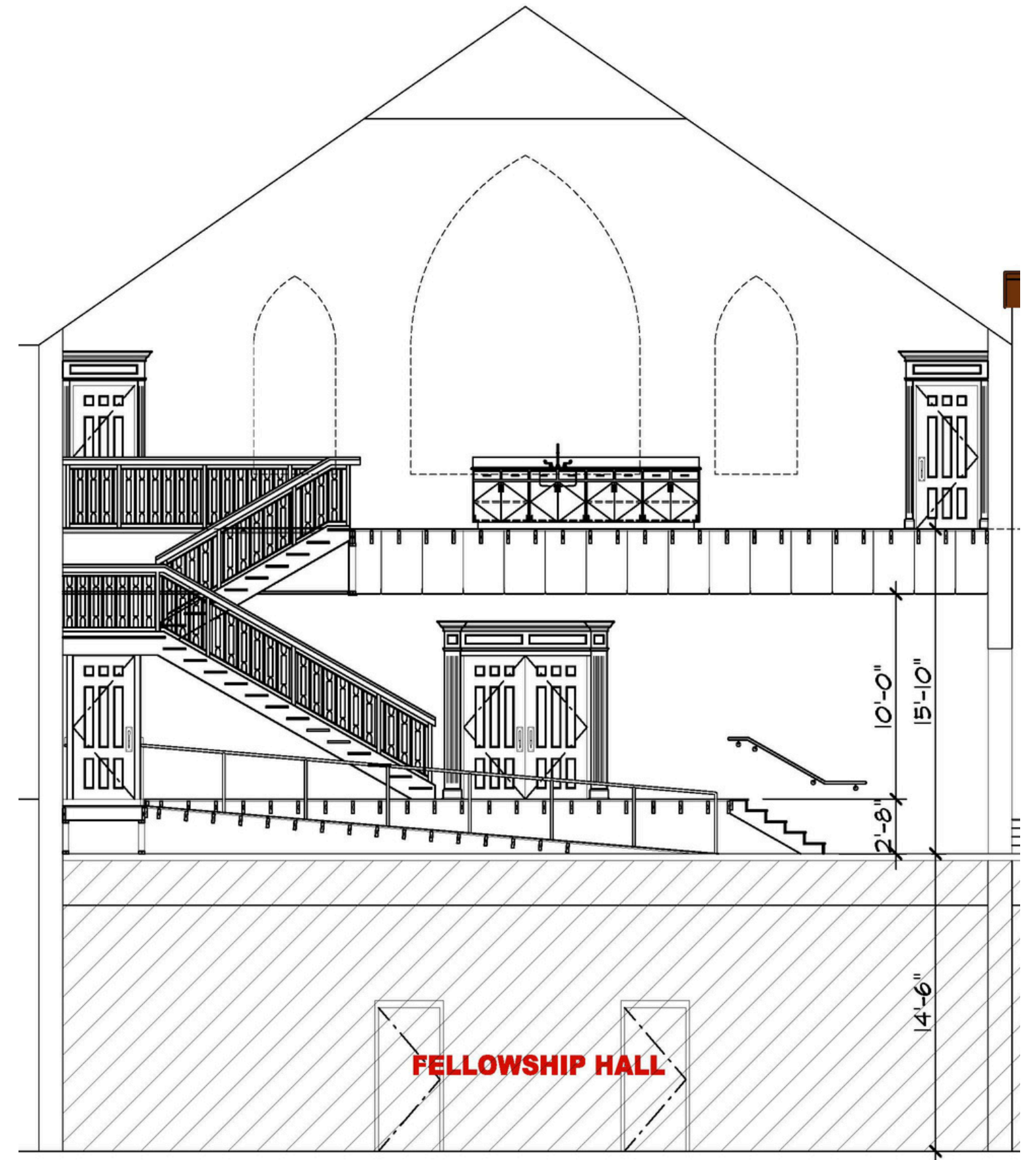

COST PROJECTION

Entire Project Total: \$6.2M +/-

***Legacy Campaign Goal: \$7.0M +/-**

*Potential cost increases per year vary. With an estimated 10% increase per year, applied costs range from \$6.8M—\$7.5M over the next three years. Therefore, our Legacy Campaign Goal is, currently, \$7.0M, despite the current cost projection being \$6.2M.

If phases are necessary, below is a potential phase/cost breakdown:

PHASE 1: \$3.95M +/-

Sanctuary/Worship Center, which includes stage, audio/video/lighting (AVL), restructure balcony + new seating, balcony stairway and upstairs landing; update original electrical/power service/panels; HVAC; south entry; brick repairs; signage; fire sprinkler expansion

PHASE 2: \$2.25M +/-

New Lobby/North Entry (structural reconfigurations), covered drop-off, office/admin renovations, new bathrooms, welcome center, secure children's building, HVAC, relocation of two-floor elevator, and fire sprinkler expansion

NEXT STEPS

FBC Enid Members will vote YES/NO for the entire project on Sunday, June 9, 2024, during a Special Called Members Meeting. Absentee ballots will be available in the church office the week leading up to June 9th. Results will be announced immediately after the vote. If there's an affirmative vote of 80% or more, we'll enter into a phase of raising funds, which includes a Capital Campaign in the Fall of 2024. Another campaign may be necessary in the future, depending on the progress of the **Legacy Campaign**. *To move forward with the entire project, 70% of the total cost must be raised in cash.* After evaluating cash-in-hand and the results of the campaign, the Vision Team and Finance Committee will determine next steps and present those steps to the church in the Winter of 2025.



June 9, 2024

FBC Enid votes YES/NO on the entire project.

If at least 80% vote YES, the project moves forward into a phase of raising funds, including a Capital Campaign in the Fall of 2024.
