1. MOVE TO THE LIGHT

WHAT YOU NEED: Flashlight; Optional: nightlight or small lamp

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Stand in the middle of the activity area with the children standing in front of you. Turn the flashlight on and point it at the floor. *Optional: Plug in*

the nightlight or turn on the lamp, and dim or turn off lights.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Shine the flashlight onto the floor in different areas of your activity area and encourage children to run to the light. Once all the children are standing on the light, move the light to a different area and encourage them to follow the light. Repeat as desired.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Introduce the Bible Story.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Everyone, come stand in front of me, and let's play a fun flashlight game!"

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "When you see the light the flashlight makes on the floor, I want you to run to it. Ready? (Point the light away from where the children are standing.) Great job! Wait for all our friends to get there! Great job! Let's do it again! (Repeat moving the light all around your activity area.) You are so good at following the light."

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Today in our Bible Story, we are going to hear how we can do what Jesus says and let our lights shine!"

TRANSITION: Move to Worship and Story by leading the children to the story area with the flashlight.

2. LIGHTS

WHAT YOU NEED: Tap lights in multiple colors, shapes, and sizes; batteries; and duct tape

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Add batteries to all tap lights; then secure each battery compartment with a piece of duct tape. Place the lights on a table.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Encourage the children to tap the lights on and off, to make a pattern out of the lights, or to see how bright each light is. You may need to dim the room lights if possible.

(Continue with each child.) Help me tap all the lights off. (Pause.) Watch the lights I tap on and off. (Tap two lights on and off.) Now you tap the lights I tapped. (Pause.) Great job! (Continue with each child.) Look at all the lights shining! It's so bright!"

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Wow, it is so fun to play with the lights and see how each of those lights shine. Today we are going to hear a story about being a light! I can't wait to hear it!"

TRANSITION: Move to Worship and Story by encouraging the children to move when the tap light is on and stop when the light is off. Hold the light and press it on and off as everyone moves to the designated area.

3. GLOW BOTTLE

WHAT YOU NEED: Empty water bottles or sensory bottles with lids, thin glow sticks, glitter glue, water, and duct tape

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Activate the glowsticks and place some in each bottle. Put a different number of glow sticks in each bottle. In some of the bottles, add about

one-half cup of glitter glue; then fill each with water. For the remaining bottles, fill some with water and leave others with just glow sticks. Replace all the lids and secure each with a piece of duct tape. Make several glow bottles per Small Group.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Encourage children to explore and talk about the different colors and how each color shines.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Introduce the Bible Story.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Wow, friends! Come join me at the table and look at the super-cool bottles we can explore today."

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "These bottles are glowing! Look at this bottle. Turn the bottles and see what happens. (*Pause.*) Wow! What colors do you see? So pretty! Okay, what happens when you shake the bottle? (*Pause.*) Let's count how many glow sticks are in this bottle. (*Pause.*) This bottle has [number] glow sticks in it, and this bottle has [number] glow sticks in it. All of these bottles are shining!"

4. FLASHLIGHT [LIVE FOR GOD | APPLICATION ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: "Flashlight Label" Activity Page, Avery® Labels #5160 or equivalent, 8-ounce paper cups, craft tubes, yellow tissue-paper squares, heart stickers, glue sticks, crayons, scissors, a hot glue gun, and a permanent marker

Note: Use the hot glue gun before children arrive and store it in another room, out of reach.

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Copy "Flashlight Label" on label paper, one label per child. For each craft tube, make four equal cuts 1/2"-3/4" long on one end. Bend the cut ends in, overlapping one over the other, and hot glue together. Hot glue this end to the bottom of a cup, one per child. Write each child's name on their cup.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Encourage children to glue yellow tissue squares to the inside of their cup and add heart stickers to the inside. Ask children to color the tube and the outside of their cup, and then add their label.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Review the Bible Story.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Friends, come sit at the table with me. I have something neat for us to make today that will help us remember our Bible Story."

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "We are going to make a flashlight! Flashlights light up and help us see things in the dark. Glue these pieces of yellow tissue to the inside of your cup. (*Pause.*) Now add some heart stickers to the inside of your cup too. (*Pause.*) Great job! Now use the crayons to decorate the outside of your cup and the tube. (*Pause.*) Now add the label to your flashlight. Great job, everyone! Your flashlights look amazing!"

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "In our Bible Story today, Jesus told His friends, the disciples, 'You are the light of the world.' That means when you are kind to people, you shine your light so people can see that Jesus is kind. When you forgive people, you shine your light so people can see that Jesus forgives. When you share with people, you shine your light so people can see that Jesus shares. When you help people, you shine your light so people can see that Jesus helps. Jesus says to shine our light to show the world that Jesus loves them and wants to be their friend forever. Who can do what Jesus says? I can do what Jesus says."
