LARGE GROUP

ENGAGE CHILDREN'S HEARTS THROUGH A DYNAMIC AND INTERACTIVE WORSHIP, BIBLE STORY, AND PRAYER EXPERIENCE IN A LARGE GROUP SETTING.

WORSHIP

WHAT YOU NEED: "Memory Verse Card" from Week One in Bible; instruments or music player; this month's worship song, "You Are with Me," included in your monthly files; and "You Love Me," available on OrangeKidsMusic.com; *Optional: Dance Moves Videos for "You Are with Me," available in the Media Package if you subscribe or from OrangeKidsMusic.com, and "You Love Me," available from OrangeKidsMusic.com*

Worship Leader enters.

WORSHIP LEADER: "Hi, friends! My name is [your name], and it's so great to see you all here today. Do you know why I'm so happy? Because it's time to sing and dance and worship God together.

"When I ask, '**Who loves you?**' I want you to say, '**God loves me. Who loves you?**'"

CHILDREN AND WORSHIP LEADER: "God loves me."

WORSHIP LEADER: "You've got it! **God loves me** and you. God loves us no matter what! Let's sing this song together!"

Lead children in singing "You Are with Me," this month's worship song.

"Yes! God is with us wherever we go. The Bible teaches us that God said, 'I (point up) will always (draw circles with finger pointing up) love you,' (cross arms over chest) Jeremiah 31:3. (Open hands like a book.) Let's do that together.

Lead children to say the Memory Verse with the motions.

"You've got it! We can know for sure that God loves us, and we can share His love with everyone, everywhere. Sing this with me."

Lead children in singing "You Love Me."

"Thanks for worshipping with me today! [**Transition**] And now it's time to turn around, sit down, and shake the wiggles out (wiggle hands), so we can hear (cup hands behind ears) what the story's all about!"

Host enters as Worship Leader exits.

10 MINUTES

INTRO SKETCH

WHAT YOU NEED: Walkie-talkie; red wagon, preschool Bible, and plush bear from previous weeks

Preset the wagon in the middle of the storytelling area. Place the Bible and teddy bear in the wagon.

Host enters with a walkie-talkie as Worship Leader exits.

HOST: "Hi, friends! Welcome to [your environment's name or story time]! My name is [your name]."

Walk to the center of the storytelling area, holding the walkie-talkie near your mouth.

"One, two. One, two. Do you know what this is?"

"Let me give you a hint. I push this button and talk into it. Then I wait to hear my friend talk. Shout it out if you know what it's called. (Pause.) That's right! It's a walkie-talkie."

"I have been going everywhere with this little red wagon. So, I decided I would put a walkie-talkie in it so I could talk to my friends wherever I go. Show me how you can hold a walkie-talkie to talk to your friends."

Encourage preschoolers to pretend to hold a walkie-talkie by holding a curled hand up near their face.

"Let's take our wagon for a ride and try talking back and forth with our walkie-talkies."

Move wagon to the front of the storytelling area.

"I could go to the mailbox with the little red wagon and say to my friends . . ."

Talk into the walkie-talkie.

"I got a cool postcard in the mail all the way from Hawaii! Can you say, 'Wow!' in your walkie-talkies?"

CHILDREN AND HOST: "Wow!"

Move wagon to the side of the storytelling area.

HOST: "I could go to the playground with the little red wagon and say to my friends . . ."

Talk into the walkie-talkie.

"I'm making bubbles at the playground. Can you say, 'So cool!'"

CHILDREN AND HOST: "So cool!"

HOST: "I could go to the garden with the little red wagon and say to my friends . . ."

Talk into the walkie-talkie.

"I see some pretty red and yellow flowers. Can you say, 'That's awesome?'"

CHILDREN AND HOST: "That's awesome!"

HOST: "Great job using your walkie-talkies. Now [Storyteller's name] has a Bible Story for you about something else we can talk to our friends about."

Storyteller enters as Host places the walkie-talkie in the wagon and exits.

STORY

WHAT YOU NEED: Bible and plastic megaphone; *Optional: Story Images and cardstock*

*Preset the megaphone in the storytelling area.
Storyteller enters, carrying a Bible, as Host exits.*

STORYTELLER: "Hello, friends! I'm [your name], and I can't wait to tell you a true story from the Bible."

Open Bible for children to see, then set it down.

"This true story from the Bible is about a man named Jeremiah."

(Option: Display Story Image W3 01)

"Jeremiah was a prophet. That means his job was to talk about God to others. Jeremiah told other people God's messages."

(Option: Display Story Image W3 02)

"One day, God gave Jeremiah a very special message to give to the people."

"Let's pretend we are Jeremiah and we are giving the people a very special message from God. I'll use this megaphone and you can use pretend megaphones. Just hold your hands like this."

Cup hands around your mouth.

"Now say what I say. 'I have a message!'"

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: *(Into megaphone.)* "I have a message!"

STORYTELLER: "Very good! Jeremiah talked about God with others. He gave the people a message from God. He said, 'God has plans for you. And God will always love you!'"

"Let's talk about God and say what Jeremiah said!"

Cup hands around your mouth.

"Say this with me: 'God has plans for you.'"

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: *(Into megaphone.)* "God has plans for you."

STORYTELLER: *(Cup hands around mouth.)* "Say this with me: 'God will always love you!'"

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: *(Into megaphone.)* "God will always love you!"

STORYTELLER: "We did it! And we can keep doing it because we can talk about God with others like Jeremiah did! We can talk about God to others and tell them that God loves them and God has plans for them!"

"Can you think of someone you can talk about God to?"

Encourage children to respond.

"That's right!"

(Option: Display Story Image W3 03)

"We can talk about God with our friends, our neighbors, the person at the grocery store, our teachers, and all our family too! Because God LOVES everyone! That means God loves you and **God loves me. Who loves you?**"

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: "God loves me!"

STORYTELLER: "Yes, **God loves me.** [Transition] Our story time is over *(pick up and close Bible)*, but we're not through. Let's talk to God because God loves you!"

PRAYER

STORYTELLER: "Dear God, help me talk to my friends and my family about You just like Jeremiah did. I want them to know that You love them and that You love me too! Thank You for loving me. In Jesus' name, we pray, amen."

"Be sure to talk to a friend or someone in your house about God today. I'll see you next time. Bye!"

Host enters as Storyteller exits, carrying Bible.

OUTRO SKETCH

WHAT YOU NEED: Walkie-talkie *(from Intro)*

Host enters as Storyteller exits.

HOST: "Wow! Jeremiah talked about God to others and we can too!"

"I think I *(point to self)* got the story. Did you *(point to children)* get it? If you did, say, 'Got it!' Get it?" *(Cup one hand behind ear.)*

CHILDREN AND HOST: "Got it!"

HOST: *(Give two thumbs-up.)* "Good!"

Hold up walkie-talkie.

"You know, I'm going to use this walkie-talkie to talk about God with my friends and tell them that God loves them!"

[Transition] "And now it's time for more Bible fun. There's more to learn. Come on, everyone!"

Host dismisses small groups and exits.

GETTING READY

HERE'S EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW TO GET READY FOR THIS WEEK

Gather children for a Large Group time that includes interactive worship, the introductory sketch, and the Bible Story. The Stage Script is written for those who gather their preschoolers together from multiple rooms and have a larger space on which to present the Bible Story. If you are pulling your children to a rug on one side of your preschool space, you may benefit from using the Rug Script.

WORSHIP: INVITING PEOPLE TO RESPOND TO GOD (10 MINUTES)

A Worship Leader and live instruments are recommended to sing along with the music tracks. Encourage children to be active during worship by incorporating the appropriate hand motions.

STORY: COMMUNICATING GOD'S TRUTH IN ENGAGING WAYS (10 MINUTES)

Choose an adult or teenager who relates well to preschoolers to tell the Introductory Sketch. If possible, use the same person for an entire month, as the Host role stays the same each month.

Choose an engaging adult to tell the Bible story. This person should be able to command the attention of preschoolers and control the group through animated storytelling. These scripts are written to be "told" and not "read." Advanced preparation is necessary.

1. WORSHIP

WHAT YOU NEED:

- Leader(s)
- Instruments or music player
- "Memory Verse Card" from Week One, placed in Bible at Jeremiah 31:3

MUSIC AND SOUND EFFECTS:

- This month's worship song, "You Are with Me," included in your monthly files
- "You Love Me," available on the Never Better album on OrangeKidsMusic.com

OPTIONAL VIDEOS (AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE):

- Dance Moves Music Video for "You Are with Me," available in the Media Package if you subscribe or from OrangeKidsMusic.com

WHAT YOU DO:

- Download all songs and have them ready to use.

2. INTRO/OUTRO SKETCH

WHAT YOU NEED:

- Walkie-talkie
- Items from previous weeks:
 - Wagon
 - Preschool Bible
 - Plush bear
- Note: Save the wagon, preschool Bible, plush bear, and walkie-talkie to use for the rest of the month.

WHAT YOU DO:

- Place the Bible and teddy bear in the wagon.

3. BIBLE STORY

WHAT YOU NEED:

- Bible
- Plastic megaphone
- Optional: Story Images and cardstock
