"Thanks for worshipping with me today! **[Transition]** And now it's time to turn around, sit down, and shake the wiggles out (*wiggle hands*), so we can hear (*cup hands behind ears*) what the story's all about!"

Host enters as Worship Leader exits.

INTRO SKETCH

WHAT YOU NEED: Painting smock or apron, big paintbrush, and small paintbrush

Host wears painting smock or apron and carries paintbrushes.

Host enters as Worship Leader exits.

HOST: "Hello, friends! Welcome to [your environment or story time]! My name is [your name], and this week I did something SO fun. I invited all of my friends to . . . a paint party!

"First, I set up all the paints outside. Then we began painting! First, we painted with BIG brushes. Hold up your pretend paintbrush and paint big, long lines with me.

Pretend to paint in long strokes with the big paintbrush.

"Then, we painted with little brushes. Pretend to paint little, tiny dots with me.

Pretend to paint in short strokes with the little paintbrush.

"Next, we painted with our fingers!

Wiggle your fingers.

"The paint felt so ooey, gooey. It was awesome! And of course, we had a paint party finale . . . splatter painting! We dipped our paintbrushes in the paint . . .

Pretend to dip a paintbrush in paint.

"... and then we SPLATTERED paint on paper!

Pretend to splatter paint toward children.

"My paint party was SO. MUCH. FUN. (*Pause.*) But the mess we made . . . Whew! I knew when I saw that mess that it was going to be SO hard to clean up. Oh, [name of Storyteller] has a true story from the Bible about some people who did something really hard. I'll be back later. Bye!"

Storyteller enters as Host exits with paintbrushes.

STORY

WHAT YOU NEED: Toy saw, toy hammer, cardboard bricks, large bin, and Bible; Optional: Story Images and cardstock

Fill the large bin with cardboard bricks, a toy saw, and a toy hammer. Preset the bin in the storytelling area.

Storyteller enters, carrying a Bible, as Host exits.

STORYTELLER: "Hello, everyone! I'm [your name], and I am here to tell you a true story from the Bible.



Open Bible for children to see, then set it down.

10 MINUTES

"Today's story begins with a beautiful building called the temple.

(Option: Display Story Image W3 01)

"The temple is where God's people would meet to learn about God and worship God, kind of like we do here at church. The temple was a very special place, but it had been destroyed.

(Option: Display Story Image W3 02)

"So God's people decided to rebuild the temple! Now rebuilding the temple was going to be a very hard job.

"Let's pretend to help the people rebuild the temple. Take out your pretend saw.

Hold up a toy saw.

"Ready? Everyone, saw with me!

Pretend to saw back and forth.

"Back and forth. Back and forth. Back and forth. Whew! You can put your saw away. Take out your pretend hammers.

Hold up a toy hammer.

"Ready? Let's hammer!

Pretend to hammer.

"You can put your pretend hammer away. It's time to lift some heavy bricks. Pretend you are holding something really heavy.

Pick up a cardboard brick with both hands, pretending it is very heavy.

"Now pass your brick to someone next to you.

Place the brick on the floor and build a simple line of bricks while you encourage the children to pass bricks.

"These bricks are so heavy! Pick up another brick and pass it to the person next to you. Keep passing the bricks! Whew! You can stop now. That was hard!

(Option: Display Story Image W3 03)

"And it was really hard for God's people. They worked and worked and worked and they finished the first part of the temple!



"Temples are really big, and it was going to take a lot of hard work to rebuild it. But some people started celebrating that the work had begun.

(Option: Display Story Image W3 04)

"They played trumpets. Play your pretend trumpets with me!

Pretend to play a trumpet.

"They played cymbals. Play your pretend cymbals!

Pretend to play a cymbal.

"And they sang songs to God about how good God is and how thankful they were. They had so much JOY!

"We can be like the people who chose to celebrate. We can look at the good things God is doing and have joy! We can play music, sing songs, and say 'thank You' to God. We can have joy all the time-even when we do hard things!

"So when I ask you, **'Who can have joy all the time?'**, I want you to say, **'I can have joy all the time!'** Let's try that!"

STORYTELLER: "Who can have joy all the time?"

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: "I can have joy all the time!"

STORYTELLER: "How about when you do hard things? Who can have joy all the time?"

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: "I can have joy all the time!"

STORYTELLER: "Yes, **I can have joy all the time! [Transition]** Our story time is over (*pick up and close Bible*), but we're not through. Let's talk to God because God loves you!"

PRAYER

STORYTELLER: "Dear God, help us to see the good and have joy—even when we do hard things. We know You love us and are always with us, and that is worth celebrating all the time! In Jesus' name. Amen."

"Thank you for helping me with today's story. You did a great job! I'll see you next time! Bye!"

Host enters as Storyteller exits, carrying Bible.



10 MINUTES

OUTRO SKETCH

WHAT YOU NEED: No supplies needed

Host enters as Storyteller exits.

HOST: "Wow! The people had a hard job to do. Some people chose joy and celebrated God because the temple was being rebuilt!

"I think I (point to self) got the story. Did you (point to children) get it? If you did, say, 'Got it!' Get it?" (Cup one hand behind ear.)

CHILDREN AND HOST: "Got it!"

HOST: (*Give two thumbs-up.*) "Good! Cleaning up after my paint party is going to be hard, but I can choose joy.

[Transition] "And now it's time for more Bible fun. There's more to learn. Come on, everyone!"

Host dismisses small groups and exits.

GETTING READY

HERE'S EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW TO GET READY FOR THIS WEEK

Gather children for a Large Group time that includes interactive worship, the introductory sketch, and the Bible Story. The Stage Script is written for those who gather their preschoolers together from multiple rooms and have a larger space on which to present the Bible Story. If you are pulling your children to a rug on one side of your preschool space, you may benefit from using the Rug Script.

WORSHIP: INVITING PEOPLE TO RESPOND TO GOD (10 MINUTES)

A Worship Leader and live instruments are recommended to sing along with the music tracks. Encourage children to be active during worship by incorporating the appropriate hand motions.

STORY: COMMUNICATING GOD'S TRUTH IN ENGAGING WAYS (10 MINUTES)

Choose an adult or teenager who relates well to preschoolers to tell the Introductory Sketch. If possible, use the same person for an entire month, as the Host role stays the same each month.

Choose an engaging adult to tell the Bible Story. This person should be able to command the attention of preschoolers and control the group through animated storytelling. These scripts are written to be "told" and not "read." Advanced preparation is necessary.
