10 MINUTES

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LARGE GROUP

ENGAGE CHILDREN'S HEARTS THROUGH A DYNAMIC AND INTERACTIVE WORSHIP, BIBLE STORY, AND PRAYER EXPERIENCE IN A LARGE GROUP SETTING.

WORSHIP

WHAT YOU NEED: "Memory Verse Card" Activity Page; cardstock; scissors; Bible; instruments or music player; this month's worship song, "Be a Light," included in your monthly files; and "Made Us Wonderful," available on Store. ThinkOrange.com; Optional: Dance Moves Videos for "Be a Light," available in the Media Package if you subscribe or from Store. ThinkOrange.com, and "Made Us Wonderful," available from Store. ThinkOrange.com

Worship Leader enters.

WORSHIP LEADER: "Hi, friends! My name is [your name], and I'm SO excited to see you today! We are here to worship Jesus because Jesus is the Light of the World and Jesus loves us! We can be bright lights, too, when we love like Jesus. When I ask, 'Who can love like Jesus?' I want you to say, 'I can love like Jesus!' Who can love like Jesus?"

CHILDREN AND WORSHIP LEADER: "I can love like Jesus."

WORSHIP LEADER: "Yes, you can love like Jesus and I can love like Jesus! Let's sing about how we can be a light!"

Lead children in singing "Be a Light," this month's worship song.

"What a great song! We'll sing it all month long. The Bible teaches us that Jesus said: 'You (point to others) are the light (twinkle fingers) of the world,' (make a circle with your arms) Matthew 5:14. (Open hands like a book.)

"Let's learn our Memory Verse together. Are you ready? Watch me say it and do the motions, and then you can do it with me!

Lead children to say the Memory Verse with the motions.

"Great job, friends! Jesus is the Light and we can be bright lights when we love like Jesus loves! Who can love like Jesus?"

CHILDREN AND WORSHIP LEADER: "I can love like Jesus."

WORSHIP LEADER: "That's right! You are wonderfully made to love others. Sing this with me."

Lead children in singing "Made Us Wonderful."



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"Thanks for worshipping with me today! **[Transition]** And now it's time to turn around, sit down, and shake the wiggles out (wiggle hands), so we can hear (cup hands behind ears) what the story's all about!"

Host enters as Worship Leader exits.

PRELUDE SOCIAL WORSHIP STORY GROUPS HOME

10 MINUTES

INTRO SKETCH

WHAT YOU NEED: Small table, flashlight, fiber optic wand, and plasma ball; *Optional: Extension cord and painter's* tape

Note: If you do not have a fiber optic wand or plasma ball, substitute any funshaped lamp, lava lamp, or disco light, and adjust the script accordingly.

Preset a table in the storytelling area. Place the fiber optic wand and plasma ball on the table. Plug in the plasma ball. If using an extension cord, tape the cable to the floor with painter's tape to avoid tripping hazards.

Host enters as Worship Leader exits. Host carries the flashlight.

HOST: "Hi, friends! Welcome to [your environment's name or story time]! My name is [your name]. Guess what? I have some cool lights, and I want you to see how they shine bright. Like my flashlight!

Turn on the flashlight, and shine it around the room above the children's heads.

"Raise your hand if you have a flashlight to help you see in the dark. (Pause.) So many of you!

Place flashlight on the table. Pick up the fiber optic wand, and turn it on.

"Now check this out. See how it lights up all the way to the very end? It's so fun to move around and watch the light.

Set the fiber optic wand on the table. Pick up the plasma ball or move it to the front of the table.

"I love how this one lights up! Look at what happens when I touch it.

Touch the plasma ball so it lights up.

"The light moves! I could watch that forever.

"These lights are really bright, but [Storyteller's name] has a true story from the Bible about the brightest Light! See you later, friends."

Storyteller enters as Host exits, leaving all lights on the table.

STORY

WHAT YOU NEED: Table (from Intro), Bible, flashlight, fiber optic wand, and plasma ball (from Intro); tri-fold foam core presentation board; battery-operated poster lights or string lights; red glitter paint; paintbrush; scissors; painter's tape; Optional: Story Images and cardstock

Storyteller enters as Host exits. Storyteller carries a Bible and the prepared tri-fold presentation board and lays the board on the table. The heart should be hidden from children's views.

STORYTELLER: "Hello, friends! I'm [your name], and I can't wait to tell you a true story from the Bible.

10 MINUTES

Open the Bible for children to see, then set it down.

"Today's true story from the Bible begins with the whole world.

(Option: Display Story Image W1 01)

"God made the whole world and everything in it. Then God made people, and God gave a gift for all people. God sent someone really special.

"Raise your hand if you think you know who God sent for everyone. We celebrate this special person being born on Christmas. Do you know who it is? (*Pause*.) Yes, it's Jesus!

(Option: Display Story Image W1 02)

"God sent Jesus to be the Light of the World.

Turn on the flashlight, and shine it around the room, avoiding children's eyes..

"Now, Jesus is not a light like a flashlight.

Place the flashlight on the table next to the lights Host left behind. Hold up the fiber optic wand.

"Jesus is not a light like this.

Place the fiber optic wand on the table. Touch the plasma ball to make it light up.

"Jesus is not a light like this plasma ball.

"Jesus is a light who helps us see how amazing God is.

(Option: Display Story Image W1 03)

"When Jesus helped people, He was a bright light showing us how God helps people.

(Option: Display Story Image W1 04)

"When Jesus forgave people, He was a bright light showing us how God forgives people.

Hold up the tri-fold board with the heart on it. Open the board up so the heart is visible.

(Option: Display Story Image W1 05)

"When Jesus loved people, He was a bright light showing us how God loves people and how we can love people too.

Turn on the lights on the heart board.

"If our friend needs help learning to play a game, we can love like Jesus and help them.

"If our brother or sister knocks down our block tower, we can love like Jesus and forgive them.

"If our friend is sad, we can love like Jesus and ask them if they would like a hug.

"I'm so glad God sent Jesus to be the Light of the World and show us how to love others. We can all love like Jesus. **Who can love like Jesus?"**

CHILDREN AND STORYTELLER: "I can love like Jesus!"

STORYTELLER: "Yes, I can love like Jesus. [Transition] Our story time is over (pick up and close Bible), but we're not through. Let's talk to God because God loves you!"

PRAYER

STORYTELLER: "God, thank You for sending Your Son, Jesus, to be our friend forever. Jesus showed us how to love others. Help us to be bright lights and love like Jesus everywhere we go. We love You. In Jesus' name, we pray. Amen.

"I'll see you next time. Bye!"

Host enters as Storyteller exits, carrying Bible.

OUTRO SKETCH

WHAT YOU NEED: Flashlight, fiber optic wand, and plasma ball (from Intro)

The lights are still on the table.

Host enters as Storyteller exits.

HOST: "Wow! God gave us Jesus to show us how to love. Jesus really is the Light of the World!

"I think I (point to self) got the story. Did you (point to children) get it? If you did, say, 'Got it!' Get it?" (Cup one hand behind ear.)

CHILDREN AND HOST: "Got it!"

HOST: (Give two thumbs-up.) "Good!

"These lights are all really bright, but Jesus is the brightest Light of the whole world! See you next time!

[Transition] "And now it's time for more Bible fun. There's more to learn. Come on, everyone!"

Host dismisses small groups and exits.

GETTING READY

HERE'S EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW TO GET READY FOR THIS WEEK

Gather children for a Large Group time that includes interactive Worship, the Intro Sketch, and the Bible Story. The Stage Script is written for those who gather their preschoolers together from multiple rooms and have a larger space on which to present the Bible Story. If you are pulling your children to a rug on one side of your preschool space, you may benefit from using the Rug Script.

WORSHIP: INVITING PEOPLE TO RESPOND TO GOD (10 MINUTES)

A Worship Leader and live instruments are recommended to sing along with the music tracks. Encourage children to be active during worship by incorporating the appropriate hand motions.

STORY: COMMUNICATING GOD'S TRUTH IN ENGAGING WAYS (10 MINUTES)

Choose an adult or teenager who relates well to preschoolers to tell the Intro Sketch. If possible, use the same person for an entire month, as the Host role stays the same each month.

Choose an engaging adult to tell the Bible Story. This person should be able to command the attention of preschoolers and control the group through animated storytelling. These scripts are written to be "told" and not "read." Advance preparation is necessary.

WHAT YOU NEED:

- Small table
- Flashlight
- Fiber optic wand, such as https://a.co/d/dioYhQO
- Plasma ball, such as https://a.co/d/7iXzVIJ
- Note: If you do not have a fiber optic wand or plasma ball, substitute any fun-shaped lamp, lava lamp, or disco light, and adjust the script accordingly.
- Optional: Extension cord and painter's tape

WHAT YOU DO:

- Preset the table in the storytelling area.
- Place the fiber optic wand and plasma ball on the table.
- Plug in the plasma ball.
- Optional: If using an extension cord, tape the cable with painter's tape to avoid tripping hazards.

3. BIBLE STORY

WHAT YOU NEED:

- Table (from Intro)
- Bible
- Flashlight, fiber optic wand, and plasma ball (from Intro)
- Tri-fold foam core presentation board
- Battery-operated poster lights or string lights, such as https://a.co/d/6D3PbzF
- Red glitter paint
- Paintbrush
- Scissors
- Painter's tape
- Optional: Story Images and cardstock

LARGE GROUP VISUALS:

WHAT YOU DO:

- Paint a large red heart on the tri-fold presentation board using the red glitter paint.
- Punch holes through the board around the inside of the heart, one hole per light on the LED string lights.
- Push the LED lights through the hole from the back and tape the cords to the board.
- Tape the control box to the top of the board.
- Option: Copy Story Images on cardstock or download to display on a device or screen.
