### WEEK 1

### WEEK 2

**Story Focus: God made me to create, think, and help.** God made ALL people, and people are the most special thing God made because God made us to be like Him. When people have the passion to create, they are reflecting God who made everything. When people think about justice, order, and laws of nature, they are reflecting God who is wise. When a person helps someone in need, they are reflecting God who helps His people. God made us to be like Him - to be creative, to think, and to help! God made us all wonderful.

### WEEK 3

**Story Focus: I am important to God.** God knows everything about us. God knows when we sit and when we stand. God knows what we are going to say before we say it.
